Report of the trustees For the year ended 31 March 2024

The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2024. The trustees who served during the year and up to the date of this report are set out on page 1.

Structure governance and management

Governing document

As from 1 April 2018 the Association has run as a CIO, charity number 117496 although the unincorporated charity 279975 is still open. Trustees hold monthly meetings and members have attended training in governance.

The Charity was governed by a constitution dated 15 April 1980 as amended 30 September 1980 and 8 March 1984. The charity had officially changed its name to Ilfracombe & District Community Transport Association and is so registered with the Charity Commission, HM Revenue and Customs and its bankers among others. The Association has had trustee indemnity insurance in place since the beginning of 2008.

Structure

The charity is an incorporated trust. To comply with Devon County Council requirements for the granting of contracts we began operating as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (Charity No. 1174976) in April 2018. We have kept our charitable objectives, Trustees and other information the same as for Charity 279975 which we intend to keep as dormant.

Trustee selection

The Trustee Shirley Jones, who was Secretary/Treasurer retired at the beginning of this financial year. Dee Rogers also resigned as a Trustee due to ill-health. Sue Piercy agreed to join as a Trustee, leaving the number of Trustees at 4. Despite big efforts having been made to recruit new Trustees, unfortunately there has been no success so far. Any new trustees would be voted in by the existing trustees following induction. Trustees give their time voluntarily but claim expenses incurred directly as a result of their role. One of the Trustees, Martin Conliffe, receives payment for the essential work he does. The Trustees consulted Charity Commissions regulations and sought legal advice about this and notified the Charity Commission in August 2023. Steps have been taken to ensure that no conflict of interest can arise

Objectives and activities

Objectives

The Constitution states that the object of the Association shall be to relieve persons who are handicapped, aged, blind or otherwise disabled by providing suitable and affordable transport which can, where necessary, be door-to-door.

Activities

We provide transport for the frail and disabled persons of all ages to enable them to attend hospital and other medical-related appointments, shopping trips, social outings, meetings and events etc. The charity is staffed by volunteers, apart from a Fleet Manager who is also a driver and a part time admin assistant and it is a non- profitmaking organisation. Income is by means of a mileage charge for the use of the vehicles, which goes towards the running costs, i.e. diesel, maintenance, insurance and administration. Any surplus funds will be paid into a separate account towards the cost of replacing vehicles. The vehicles are available for those permitted to use them under Section 19 and section 22 permits within a 45-mile radius of Ilfracombe. They are also available for community groups and private hire when not already booked for our primary purpose.

Personnel:

At the beginning of 2023, Shirley Jones who had been the Secretary and Treasurer for many years, informed the Trustees of her intention to retire. The trustees had been looking for new premises, as they felt using someone's home was no longer appropriate and in April they agreed to rent a shop in Ilfracombe High Street. This involved work and cost to provide furniture and equipment. In June, the part time admin assistant informed the Trustees that she could not commit to work at the shop and wanted to continue working from home, so she handed in her resignation. We now have a new admin assistant, who is settling into the position. Dee rogers, who has been a Trustee for many years, but has been dealing with ill health for some time also resigned. Sue Piercy offered to join as a Trustee and this was agreed by the other Trustees. The operation of the services, maintenance of the minibuses and allocation of drivers is the responsibility of the only full-time paid employee, the Fleet Manager, who is also a driver. There were six part-time paid drivers.

Achievements and performance:

It has been a difficult year with all the changes and many hurdles have had to be overcome, but the Trustees are happy that things are now settled and are confident all will go well in the future.

Allan Day, Fleet Manager/Driver has instigated several new projects. Among them is the "Hopper" service, which picks up passengers in all areas of the town and takes them to Ilfracombe High Street or the market on the seafront. He has also worked with the Exmoor authority to provide transport for lonely or isolated people to explore the beauty of Exmoor. We continue to run all our essential Ring & Ride services and our connection with the Straw Patch Project continued, regularly taking beneficiaries to engage in a wide range of outdoor and indoor activities to the betterment of their health and wellbeing.

Fund-Raising:

There has not been any fundraising this year due to the pressure of dealing with all the changes, but there are plans to hold a Xmas raffle, which will hopefully raise some funds.

Reserves Policy:

The Association is always committed to holding enough reserves to deal with future commitments. Our primary aim is to always have at least £25,000 in reserve to pay redundancy if we had to cease operating plus at least one month's average expenditure of £37,000. We also like to have a healthy reserve for buying a new bus in the event of one of our buses suddenly needing replacing. In the past we had a separate "vehicle Account", but since we changed to Santander and all the difficulties caused by name changes, we have not yet been able to do this, but efforts are being made to remedy this.

Future Developments:

At the moment our Fleet Manager is looking for a new minibus to replace one which is coming to the end of its life. This will be done with the help of a donation we have been promised from a local windfarm. A sum of £20,000 from our vehicle fund has been earmarked for this. We continue to look for opportunities to provide transport and all the benefits it creates for lonely and isolated people. The Fleet Manager is constantly looking for new reliable drivers. The difficulties involved in this are being able to offer enough regular hours and also the high cost of training and licensing of new drivers, whilst not being able to insist on commitment from them to continue driving for us.

Serious Incidents:

The Trustees report that there have been no serious incidents this year.

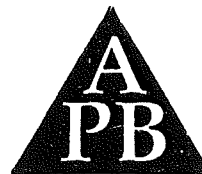
Basis of independent examiner's statement



1. Accounting policies

The principal accounting policies are summarised below. The accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the year and the preceding period.

1.1. Basis of accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, except for the revaluation of certain fixed assets and except for investments which are included at market value, and in accordance with the statement of Recommended Practice 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities' issued in March 2005 (SORP 2005) and the Charities Act 1993.

1.2. Cashflow

The charity has taken advantage of the exemption in FRS102 from the requirement to produce a cashflow statement because it is a small charity.

1.3 Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds are donations and other incoming resources receivable or generated for the objects of the charity without further specific purpose and which the charity may use for its purpose at its discretion

Designated funds are subjected to restrictions on their expenditure imposed by the donor or through the terms of an appeal.

Endowment funds are retained intact and must not be spent.

1.4 Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be qualified with reasonable accuracy. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income.

Voluntary income is received by way of grants, donations and gifts and is included in full in the statement of financial activities when receivable. Grants where entitlement is not conditional on the delivery of a specific performance by the charity are recognised when the charity becomes unconditionally entitled to the grant.

Donated services and facilities are included at the value to the charity where this can be qualified. The value of services provided by volunteers has not been included.

Gifts donated for resale are included as incoming resources within activities for generating funds when they are sold.

Grants, including grants for the purchase of fixed assets, are recognised in full in the statement of financial activities in the year in which they are receivable.

Income from investments is included in the year which it is receivable.

1.5 Resources expended

Expenditure is recognised on an accrual basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes any VAT which cannot be fully recovered and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

Costs of generating funds comprise the costs associated with attracting voluntary income and the costs of trading for fundraising purposes.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the charity in the delivery of its activities and services for its beneficiaries. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.

Support costs are those costs incurred directly in support of expenditure on the objects of the charity and include project management.

1.6 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

The Trustee Shirley Jones, who was Secretary/Treasurer retired at the beginning of this financial year. Dee Rogers also resigned as a Trustee due to ill-health. Activities

We provide transport for the frail and disabled persons of all ages to enable them to attend hospital and other medical-related appointments, shopping trips, social outings, meetings and events etc. The charity is staffed by volunteers, apart from a Fleet Manager who is also a driver and a part time admin assistant and it is a non- profitmaking organisation. Income is by means of a mileage charge for the use of the vehicles, which goes towards the running costs, i.e. diesel, maintenance, insurance and administration. Any surplus funds will be paid into a separate account towards the cost of replacing vehicles. The vehicles are available for those permitted to use them under Section 19 and section 22 permits within a 45-mile radius of Ilfracombe. They are also available for community groups and private hire when not already booked for our primary purpose.

Personnel:

At the beginning of 2023, Shirley Jones who had been the Secretary and Treasurer for many years, informed the Trustees of her intention to retire. The trustees had been looking for new premises, as they felt using someone's home was no longer appropriate and in April they agreed to rent a shop in Ilfracombe High Street. This involved work and cost to provide furniture and equipment. In June, the part time admin assistant informed the Trustees that she could not commit to work at the shop and wanted to continue working from home, so she handed in her resignation. We now have a new admin assistant, who is settling into the position. Dee rogers, who has been a Trustee for many years, but has been dealing with ill health for some time also resigned. Sue Piercy offered to join as a Trustee and this was agreed by the other Trustees. The operation of the services, maintenance of the minibuses and allocation of drivers is the responsibility of the only full-time paid employee, the Fleet Manager, who is also a driver. There were six part-time paid drivers.

Achievements and performance:

It has been a difficult year with all the changes and many hurdles have had to be overcome, but the Trustees are happy that things are now settled and are confident all will go well in the future.

Allan Day, Fleet Manager/Driver has instigated several new projects. Among them is the "Hopper" service, which picks up passengers in all areas of the town and takes them to Ilfracombe High Street or the market on the seafront. He has also worked with the Exmoor authority to provide transport for lonely or isolated people to explore the beauty of Exmoor. We continue to run all our essential Ring & Ride services and our connection with the Straw Patch Project continued, regularly taking beneficiaries to engage in a wide range of outdoor and indoor activities to the betterment of their health and wellbeing.

Fund-Raising:

There has not been any fundraising this year due to the pressure of dealing with all the changes, but there are plans to hold a Xmas raffle, which will hopefully raise some funds.

Reserves Policy:

The Association is always committed to holding enough reserves to deal with future commitments. Our primary aim is to always have at least £25,000 in reserve to pay redundancy if we had to cease operating plus at least one month's average expenditure of £37,000. We also like to have a healthy reserve for buying a new bus in the event of one of our buses suddenly needing replacing. In the past we had a separate "vehicle Account", but since we changed to Santander and all the difficulties caused by name changes, we have not yet been able to do this, but efforts are being made to remedy this.

Future Developments:

At the moment our Fleet Manager is looking for a new minibus to replace one which is coming to the end of its life. This will be done with the help of a donation we have been promised from a local windfarm. A sum of £20,000 from our vehicle fund has been earmarked for this. We continue to look for opportunities to provide transport and all the benefits it creates for lonely and isolated people. The Fleet Manager is constantly looking for new reliable drivers. The difficulties involved in this are being able to offer enough regular hours and also the high cost of training and licensing of new drivers, whilst not being able to insist on commitment from them to continue driving for us.

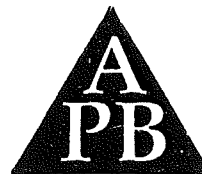



1. Accounting policies

Fund-Raising:

There has not been any fundraising this year due to the pressure of dealing with all the changes, but there are plans to hold a Xmas raffle, which will hopefully raise some funds.

Reserves Policy:

The Association is always committed to holding enough reserves to deal with future commitments. Our primary aim is to always have at least £25,000 in reserve to pay redundancy if we had to cease operating plus at least one month's average expenditure of £37,000. We also like to have a healthy reserve for buying a new bus in the event of one of our buses suddenly needing replacing. In the past we had a separate "vehicle Account", but since we changed to Santander and all the difficulties caused by name changes, we have not yet been able to do this, but efforts are being made to remedy this.

Future Developments:

At the moment our Fleet Manager is looking for a new minibus to replace one which is coming to the end of its life. This will be done with the help of a donation we have been promised from a local windfarm. A sum of £20,000 from our vehicle fund has been earmarked for this. We continue to look for opportunities to provide transport and all the benefits it creates for lonely and isolated people. The Fleet Manager is constantly looking for new reliable drivers. The difficulties involved in this are being able to offer enough regular hours and also the high cost of training and licensing of new drivers, whilst not being able to insist on commitment from them to continue driving for us.

Serious Incidents:

The Trustees report that there have been no serious incidents this year.



1. Accounting policies

Support costs are those costs incurred directly in support of expenditure on the objects of the charity and include project management.

**Report of the trustees

The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2022. The trustees who served during the year and up to the date of this report are set out on page 1.

Structure governance and management

Governing document

As from 1 April 2018 the Association has run as a CIO, charity number 117496 although the unincorporated charity 279975 is still open. Trustees hold monthly meetings and members have attended training in governance.

The Charity was governed by a constitution dated 15 April 1980 as amended 30 September 1980 and 8 March 1984. The charity had officially changed its name to Ilfracombe & District Community Transport Association and is so registered with the Charity Commission, HM Revenue and Customs and its bankers among others. New trustees are voted in by the existing trustees. Additional trustees are actively being sought.

Objectives and activities

Objectives

The Constitution states that the object of the Association shall be to relieve persons who are handicapped, aged, blind or otherwise disabled by providing suitable and affordable transport which can, where necessary, be door-to-door.

Activities

We provide transport for the frail and disabled persons of all ages to enable them to attend hospital and other medical-related appointments, shopping trips, social outings, meeting and events etc. The charity is staffed by volunteers, apart from a Fleet Manager who is also a driver and it is a non-profitmaking organisation. Income is by means of a mileage charge for the use of the vehicles which goes towards the running costs, i.e. diesel, maintenance, insurance and administration. Any surplus funds are paid into a separate account towards the cost of replacing vehicles. The vehicles are available for those permitted to use them under Section 19 and section 22 permits within a 45-mile radius of Ilfracombe. They are also available for community groups and private hire when not already booked for our primary purpose.

Personnel:

In November 2021 the Chairperson of the Association, Reg Spurway unfortunately died. Bruce Piercy, a former driver, was elected to take his place. In March 2022, Martin Condliffe was elected as a Trustee. The Association is administered by the Trustees working from their own homes supported by a part-time paid office assistant. The operation of the services, maintenance of the minibuses and allocation of drivers is the responsibility of the only full-time paid employee, the Fleet Manager, who is also a driver. There were seven part-time paid drivers and two part-time school escorts.

Achievements and performance:

Since April 2021, the country continued to be subject to government rules regarding Covid 19 and essential minibus services only were run. These were school contracts for the children of essential workers, ring and ride and the Ilfracombe Town Bus services for people to get out to buy their essential shopping which operated as normal. All health and safety precautions being taken. Passenger numbers were very low and did not pick up until government restrictions ended in mid-July. The Association is very grateful to DCC for the extra financial support during this difficult period. Other services were started up in August with reduced number of passengers, but numbers have increased since then and are now approaching pre-2020 levels. However, local community groups have been slow to get back to their activities resulting in reduced income on hiring. The Association has forged strong links with One Ilfracombe and the Straw Patch Project and now regularly take beneficiaries to engage in a wide range of outdoor and indoor activities to the betterment of their health and well-being. Maintenance costs were very high throughout the year and ways to reduce these costs are actively being sought.

Public benefit:

The Association ensured that its primary charitable objectives were fully met at reasonable cost to the passengers. All services bring benefit to the local businesses who supply us with fuel, repairs and maintenance as also do the retail establishments used by our passengers. In addition, the Association provides the opportunity for people who may feel isolated and lonely to meet others to socialise. On the journeys, many passengers tell the drivers that the minibus service is the highlight of their week. This was extremely important earlier in the year during 'lock-down'.

1. Accounting policies

The principal accounting policies are summarised below. The accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the year and the preceding period.

1.1. Basis of accounting

Grants where entitlement is not conditional on the delivery of a specific performance by the charity are recognised when the charity becomes unconditionally entitled to the grant.

Donated services and facilities are included at the value to the charity where this can be qualified. The value of services provided by volunteers has not been included.

**Report of the trustees
For the year ended 31 March 2021**

The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2021. The trustees who served during the year and up to the date of this report are set out on page 1.

Structure governance and management

Governing document

As from 1 April 2018 the Association has run as a CIO, charity number 117496 although the unincorporated charity 279975 is still open. Trustees hold monthly meetings and members have attended training in governance.

The Charity was governed by a constitution dated 15 April 1980 as amended 30 September 1980 and 8 March 1984. The charity had officially changed its name to Ilfracombe & District Community Transport Association and is so registered with the Charity Commission, HM Revenue and Customs and its bankers among others. The Association has had trustee indemnity insurance in place since the beginning of 2008.

Structure

The charity is an incorporated trust. To comply with Devon County Council requirements for the granting of contracts we began operating as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (Charity No 1174976) in April 2018. We have kept our charitable objectives, Trustees and other information the same as for Charity 279975 which we intend to keep as dormant.

Trustee selection

New trustees are voted in by the existing trustees. Additional trustees are actively being sought.

Objectives and activities

Objectives

The Constitution states that the object of the Association shall be to relieve persons who are handicapped, aged, blind or otherwise disabled by providing suitable and affordable transport which can, where necessary, be door-to-door.

Activities

We provide transport for the frail and disabled persons of all ages to enable them to attend hospital and other medical-related appointments, shopping trips, social outings, meeting and events etc. The charity is staffed by volunteers, apart from a Fleet Manager who is also a driver and it is a non-profitmaking organisation. Income is by means of a mileage charge for the use of the vehicles which goes towards the running costs, i.e. diesel, maintenance, insurance and administration. Any surplus funds are paid into a separate account towards the cost of replacing vehicles. The vehicles are available for those permitted to use them under Section 19 and section 22 permits within a 45-mile radius of Ilfracombe. They are also available for community groups and private hire when not already booked for our primary purpose.

Personnel:

The Association is administered by the Trustees working from their own homes supported by a part-time paid office assistant. The operation of the services, maintenance of the minibuses and allocation of drivers is the responsibility of the only full-time paid employee, the Fleet Manager, who is also a driver. At the start of the year there were an additional seven part-time paid drivers plus an emergency stand-in and one driver taking time off long term for family commitments. During the year, one driver changed driving duties to become an escort on a school run and another of our long-term drivers retired. We then took on two new part-time paid drivers to replace them.

Achievements and performance:

In common with other organisations, charitable or business, the past year has been an extraordinary one because of the COVID pandemic which is still on-going. Since 1 April 2020, the Association has been curtailed from providing its usual range of services, being restricted to the ones essential for health and well-being. We were able to continue our Ring & Ride services in Ilfracombe and in North Torridge to allow vulnerable people to get their daily grocery needs although the number of fare-paying passengers fell by 74%. Our Town Bus service which runs Tuesdays and Fridays continued throughout the year with a 69% fall in passengers. Fare revenue from these two services was therefore minimal. Our 3 school contracts were also impacted as schools were closed down. However, we were financially supported by Devon County Council who provided payment at 2019 rates to compensate and the drivers on these services were paid throughout whether they drove or not. We also received government funding to cover the special cleaning precautions our drivers had to take to safeguard passengers. We are very grateful for this additional financial help. Later in the year, the Association took on conveying people for their hospital appointments and for vaccinations at the request of local volunteer car schemes that were not able to operate.

During the year we sold one of our older minibuses, bought a second-hand vehicle more suitable for the narrow country lanes on one of our school contracts and also a recent used model. It is intended to sell two more of our oldest vehicles in the near future. Considering mileage was much lower than usual, maintenance costs were high during this period.

During the year the Ministry for Transport changed its regulations regarding the use of Section 19 permits and the Trustees had to consider which one category the Association's services fell into – they agreed that a) minibus transport is the main occupation, b) the short distance exemption did not apply to us, c) Exclusively non-commercial purposes exemption best suits the type of minibus services we operate and meets our charitable objectives. We confirmed that our financial systems identify whether the Association services make a surplus, where it goes and how it is used. We confirmed that any surplus made will be invested in a separate account for the purpose of replacing older vehicles. We also make financial provision according to the Charity Commission recommendation in case of having to close down.

Public benefit:

Any surplus at the end of the year goes into a Government Investment Account towards the purchase of replacement minibuses and, in addition, 3 months' average expenditure is kept should the Association have to cease operating.


