Barton Evangelical Church 2023-2024

The financial year saw some progress in the work of the charity in Barton upon Humber

Membership of the church increased by 3 as new members were added to the church.

The church's work with children in the town expanded in two ways

First the children's group that works with 5-11 years olds began meeting weekly

It had met only bi-weekly since the pandemic but now there were sufficient volunteers to make this change possible

Furthermore, the number of children the group works with has increased to an average of 25 per week

Also, the group that work with youngsters 12-18 has increased in number and began jointly working with the group that meets at another church in the locality sharing premises because the church premises in Barton are too small to accommodate the numbers comfortably

Work among the elderly continues much as it has done since the pandemic meeting bi-weekly with numbers in the low 20s: not only is this a warm space in winter but craft activities and such like are carried out and meals at the Christian festivals of the year are provided.

The weekly services of the church in the community for the community continue to be well attended for such a small town as Barton. Numbers regularly are in the 60s on a Sunday morning.

The church is now functioning normally after the pandemic.

Warm space was provided for elderly people during the winter of 22/23 every other week on a Thursday.

The childrens' and youth activities that happen every other week have grown in number of attendees over this period.

The morning church service. Continued to be held in the school Baysgarth School Barton upon Humber because the number of attendees could not be easily or comfortably accommodated in the church building.

However, the school itself has not been available each week regularly due to their staffing issues and this has meant some disruption to the continuity of the provision of our worship service in the same place each week.

Trustees and employees have remained the same over this period and income has grown significantly due to a greater number of employed people attending the services and becoming committed donating members.

Attendance returned to levels seen before the pandemic hit, youth and childrens activities
also regained their former momentum
The work of these aspects took on greater significance as numbers increased slightly
The other work of the church including that among older folk be came increasingly helpful
for both providing spiritual help and as a warm space for those in contact with the church
who found the rising cost of living a burden.
The full time employees in the church did not change
The work of the charity in funding work abroad did not change
The work continued to support ministries in Bosnia Niger and Spain
Attendance on the Sunday services increased and new members were added to the church.
This explains the increase in income.
The cost of living increases also impacted on the payment of the pastor whose salary was
subsequently increased in line with inflation


