St Nicholas at Wade Church Concert October 2022

December 2022 Beech Grove Concert

Revelation Strings performed a variety of pieces and everyone participated in singing or playing movements from The Messiah. Once again we have been invited back this year, the date is yet to be arranged.

January 2023

Sarah Smith resigned as chairperson to go to live in France for a well earned retirement. Hannah thanked her for all her hard work and support since setting up TBR charity 6 years ago.

Rosemary Dunn Concert March 2023

This was held at St. Paul's Church in Canterbury, a lovely welcoming venue. Dominic Dunn presented the Mc Carthy family with the Rosemary Dunn Award.

Matthew Sharp was able to join us. There were also performances from Alana Griffiths Ennew, Daisy Mackman and Mahaliah Edwards.

Singing Festival June 2023

Held in Charlton Church as Dover Town Hall is still being refurbished. The Singing Festival proved very popular with 400 pupils attending, so there were 2 sessions am and pm. The pupils enjoyed performing songs from the stage and screen.

July 2023 Summer Concert Staple Village Hall

We were fortunate to have lovely weather, although slightly breezy! Fran lead the orchestra and performed 2 solos, singing and playing. £200 in donations were collected from the audience for Staple church.

Future concerts and performance

Hannah told us about the upcoming events for the next academic year.

Play Day Charlton Church 18th October 2023

2 primary schools and some secondary schools will be taking part.

St Nicholas at Wade Church Concert November 18th 2023

The Revellers will be performing with Revelation Strings.

Heart of the Wood December 2023

David gave an update on the project. It will be taking place at The Dearne Playhouse, Goldthorpe, an ex mining community, near Barnsley. There will be 3 performances on 8th, 9th and 10th December. Martin, Matthew and David have been working with the local schools. The production will include actors and dancers as well as a male voice choir, ladies choir and a brass band. Barnsley Council is funding the project.

Living the Dream Part 3 "Voices in the Wilderness" March 2024

Funding from the Arts Council has been confirmed and the Kent Community have given £4,000 to sponsor the venues for the project. David, Martin and Matthew are working with about 12 Special Schools in Kent. Performances will take place in March at the 2 venues again, Canterbury, Friday 22nd and Gravesend, Wednesday 27th.

By using the latest technology, David explained how the P.M.L.D. pupils will be able to take part in the performances.
