It has raised funds for an employment skills library (non-statutory provision) which will be dispersed in 2021, which will be utilised by the young people to improve their employment prospects post lockdown.

It continues to examine how former pupils can be supported into to work and training, by removing barriers of access, and creating opportunity for all to thrive.




