The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31st August 2022.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The objects of the charity are:

for the benefit of the public to relieve the suffering of animals in need of care and attention and, in particular, to provide facilities for the reception, care, birth control and treatment of such animals, and to promote humane behaviour towards animals by providing appropriate care and treatment for animals which are in need of care and attention by reason of sickness, maltreatment, poor circumstances or ill usage and to educate the public in matters pertaining to animal welfare in general and the prevention of cruelty and suffering among animals.

The trustees have complied with the requirements of the Charity Commission with regard to public benefit.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The charity was established by a legacy from the estate of Chris Richardson.

The charity awarded grants amounting to £20,953 in the year.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

At the year end, the funds of the charity amounted to £77,127.

The charity aims to retain enough funds for urgent appeals and to ensure that sufficient cover is available for on-going projects.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is established as a Foundation Charitable Incorporated Organisation with a constitution dated 23rd October 2017.

The trustees are appointed by the existing trustees as and when a need arises; the trustee body meets on a regular basis to consider the making of grants from the charitable funds.

The Trustees regularly review business risk.
