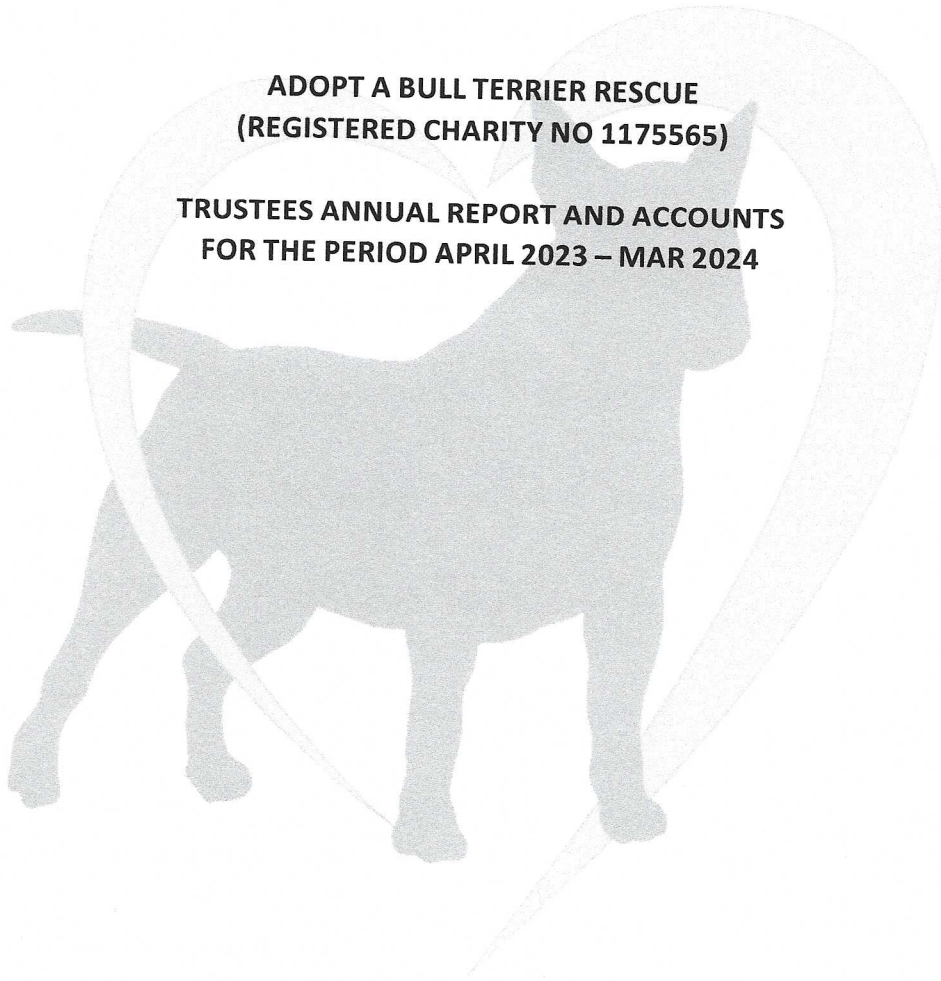

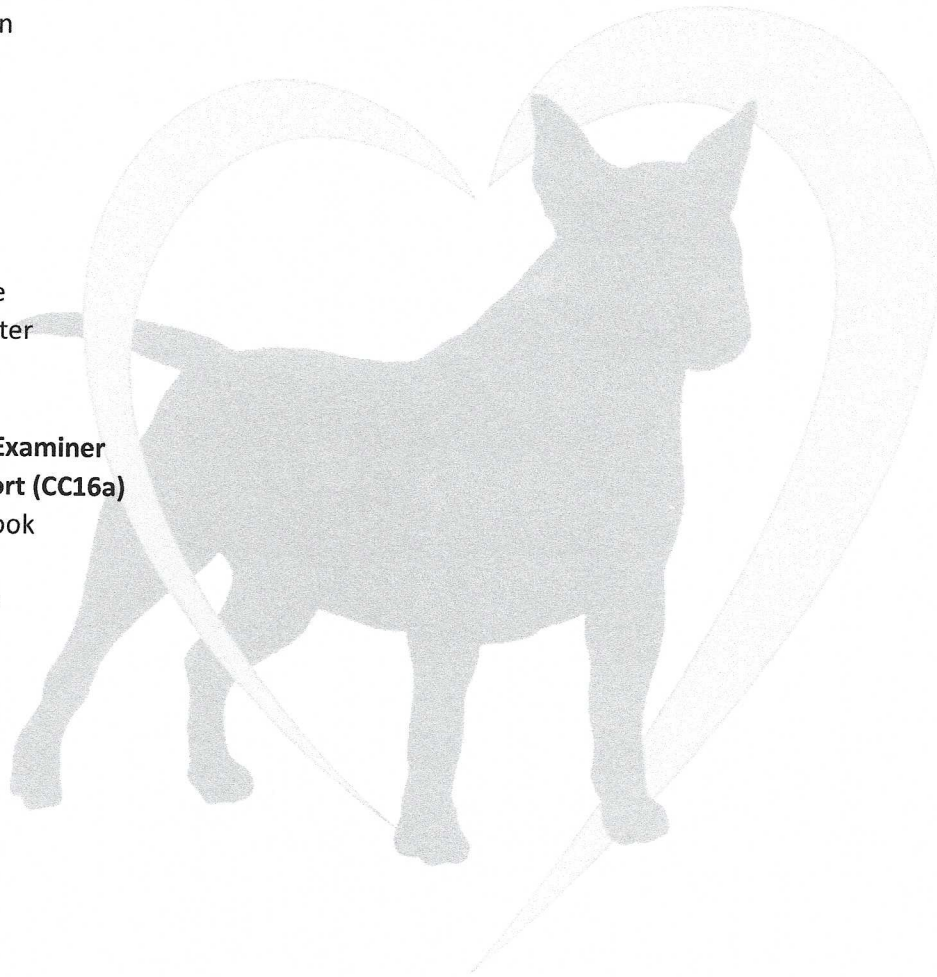

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

For the benefit of the public to relieve the suffering of dogs in need of care and attention and, in particular, to provide and maintain rescue homes or other facilities for the reception, care and treatment of such dogs.

We are one of the few rescues which help to care for disabled bull terriers which suffer from a condition known as LAD (Lethal Acrodermatitis), these special little bull terriers are lovingly known as Zincies. They suffer from dwarfism, skin issues and shortened palates. With the correct medical attention these little dogs can live up to 6 years.

AaBTR continue to be actively involved in the rescue and rehabilitation of French Bulldogs and associated crosses as well as Bull Terriers. AaBTR are committed to making an impact on the rescue of dogs in difficult situations, abandoned, in dog pounds and those on death row and strive to ensure safe & loving homes are found for all those dogs that come into our care. AaBTR is run purely on a voluntary basis. All dogs are neutered/spayed, vaccinated and microchips updated.

AaBTR have partnered with Agria Pet Insurance and going forward all dogs will have 5 weeks free pet insurance to give adopters piece of mind. AaBTR provide back up to all dogs adopted from this rescue. As such, we help our adoptees if their insurance does not cover the full vet bill, we will also offer support on a case by case basis.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Income for the period totalled £7,968 with expenditure of £8,275 resulting in a deficit for the period of - £307.

Combined with the opening cash funds balance of £106,606 gives a closing cash funds balance of **£106,299**.

The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144 (2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed. The charity's gross income does not exceed £250,000.00

REVIEW OF THE PERIOD

We have rescued/rehomed 12 Bull Terriers/French Bulldogs from April 2023 to 31 March 2024.

Each dog taken under our care undergoes an assessment prior to joining our rescue. To ensure the safety and wellbeing of our fosterers and adopters, we are unable to accept any dogs with a known history of biting or aggressive behaviour. Once in our care, all dogs receive a comprehensive health check, are vaccinated, and are neutered/spayed if suitable, with consideration given to factors such as age and/or existing medical conditions).

Our supporters play a vital role in the success of our rescue operations. Their contributions include fostering and adopting, conducting home checks, assessing new arrivals, and helping with the transportation of dogs to their new homes. Beyond rehoming, we also undertake follow-up reviews and provide continuous support and advice, ensuring a smooth transition for all parties involved.

As of the statement of financial position date, our charity remains in a strong position. We continue to rely on fundraising efforts, donations and adoptions fees to sustain operations. The support from adopters and donors has been instrumental in enabling us to provide the necessary care for our rescue dogs.


Veterinary expenses represent our largest and most essential outlay. To manage these costs, we have established partnerships with several veterinary practices allowing us to secure discounts on routine procedures such as spaying/neutering, as well as more complex surgeries requiring hospitalisation. These collaborations enable the rescue to maintain high standards of care while optimising our financial resources.

Our commitment to the dogs in our care extends well beyond the adoption process. We provide lifetime support to adopters, particularly for dogs with pre-existing medical conditions. This ensures every dog rehomed through our charity continues to receive the attention, treatment and advice needed to enjoy a healthy, happy and full life.

The period under review has been marked by achievements and ongoing dedication. We remain steadfast in our mission to rescue, rehabilitate and rehome Bull Terriers and French Bulldogs, and to support our adopters and their adopted dogs for life. We look forward to continuing our work with the help of our supports, veterinary partners and the rescue team.

All dogs which come into our rescue are health checked, vaccinated, neutered and/or spayed (as long as they meet the required criteria taking into account age and/or existing medical conditions).

Our members help by fostering and adopting, doing home checks, assessing dogs, and helping with the transport of dogs to their new homes. As a rescue, we also conduct follow up reviews and provide ongoing support and advice to all our rescue dogs and their adopters.

The financial position is strong at the statement of financial position date. The charity continues to rely on fundraising and donations to support its work. Our members have continued to be very supportive with their donations.

Vet bills remain our biggest and most necessary cost however, we have formed partnerships with several veterinary practices to endeavour to keep costs to a minimum; obtaining discounts on day-to-day surgeries such as spaying and neutering and also more complex surgeries where in-house hospitalisation is necessary.





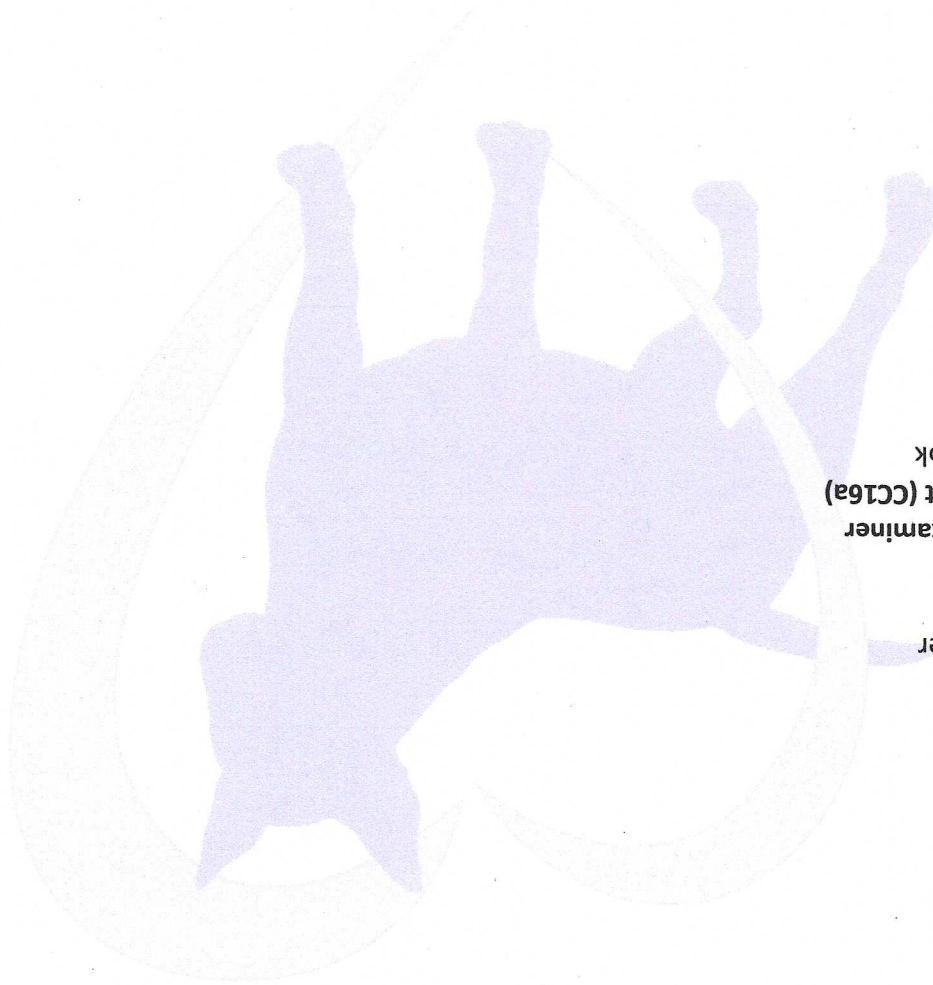

COVID 19

The COVID pandemic that commenced March 2020, was not a situation that could be foreseen or planned for, this meant that a lot of rescue activities ceased as we were unable to conduct home checks and dog assessments etc. There were also difficulties in taking existing dogs to vets due to lockdown. Funds were affected due to varying factors, including unable to do more than one socialisation walk, rehoming of dogs and general outside activities.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Income for the period totalled £37,890 with expenditure of £7,600 resulting in a surplus for the period of £30,290, which combined with the opening cash funds balance of £76,316, gives a closing cash funds balance of £106,606.

The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144 (2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed. The charity's gross income does not exceed £250,000.00

We have rescued/rehomed 57 Bull Terriers/French Bulldogs from April 2022 to 31 March 2023.





STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Adopt a Bull Terrier Rescue (AaBTR) registered charity no 1175565, operates in England and Wales to assist in the rescue, rehabilitation and rehoming of Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, Pugs and cross breeds for example Frugs, in need or at risk. Charity status was granted in November 2017 with 3 Trustees appointed to support this work. As two of the trustees are related to each other it was decided to appoint a person outside of the rescue to offer an unbiased view.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

For the benefit of the public to relieve the suffering of dogs in need of care and attention and, in particular, to provide and maintain rescue homes or other facilities for the reception, care and treatment of such dogs.

We are one of the few rescues which help to care for disabled bull terriers which suffer from a condition known as LAD (Lethal Acrodermatitis), these special little bull terriers are lovingly known as Zincies. They suffer from dwarfism, skin issues and shortened palates. With the correct medical attention these little dogs can live up to 6 years.

AaBTR continue to be actively involved in the rescue and rehabilitation of French Bulldogs and associated crosses as well as Bull Terriers.

AaBTR are committed to making an impact on the rescue of dogs in difficult situations, abandoned, in dog pounds and those on death row and strive to ensure safe & loving homes are found for all those dogs that come into our care. AaBTR is run purely on a voluntary basis. All dogs are neutered/spayed, vaccinated and microchips updated.

AaBTR have partnered with Agria Pet Insurance and going forward all dogs will have 5 weeks free pet insurance to give adopters piece of mind.

COVID 19

The COVID pandemic that commenced March 2020 and continued for several months impacted the revenue and operating capabilities into 2021, this was not a situation that could be foreseen or planned for. We struggled to conduct many rescue activities for example home checks and dog assessments etc. Funds were affected due to varying factors, socialisation walks, rehoming of dogs and general outside activities.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Income for the period totalled £27,220 with expenditure of £15,280 resulting in a surplus for the period of £11,939.

Combined with the opening cash funds balance of £64,376 gives a closing cash funds balance of **£76,316**.

The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144 (2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed. The charity's gross income does not exceed £250,000.00

REVIEW OF THE PERIOD

We are now in our fourth year as a registered charity and our reputation is growing as our financial report shows.

We have rescued/rehomed 23 Bull Terriers/French Bulldogs from April 2020 to 31 March 2021. For the period 2021 to 2022 this increased to 44. Although there was an increase in the number of rescued dogs to the previous year, this was still less than other years due to the COVID pandemic and economic issues. We were still able to operate under Animal Welfare rules however our intake was low compared to previous years. We were able to work with another registered charity to help rescue and rehome several Bull Terriers.


All dogs are assessed prior to being taken under our wing, unfortunately we cannot take any dogs known to have bitten or shown aggression as we cannot and will not put our fosterers or adopters at risk. All dogs which come into our rescue are health checked, vaccinated, neutered and/or spayed (as long as they are old enough).

Our members help by fostering and adopting, doing home checks, assessing dogs and helping with the transport of dogs to their new homes. As a rescue, we also conduct follow up reviews and provide ongoing support and advice to all our rescue dogs and their adopters.

The financial position is strong at the statement of financial position date. The charity continues to rely on fundraising and donations to support its work. Again due to the COVID pandemic our fundraising was affected, we were unable to run the usual number of Bull Terrier/Frenchie walks, however, we were able to still run auctions and the annual calendar. Our members have continued to be very supportive with their donations.

Vet bills remain our biggest and most necessary cost however, we have formed partnerships with several veterinary practices to endeavour to keep costs to a minimum; obtaining discounts on day to day surgeries such as spaying and neutering and also more complex surgeries where in-house hospitalisation is necessary.

We were still able to operate under Animal Welfare rules however our intake was low compared to previous years. We were able to work with another registered charity to help rescue and rehome several Bull Terriers.

All dogs are assessed prior to being taken under our wing, unfortunately we cannot take any dogs known to have bitten or shown aggression as we cannot and will not put our fosterers or adopters at risk. All dogs which come into our rescue are health checked, vaccinated, neutered and/or spayed (as long as they are old enough).

Our members help by fostering and adopting, doing home checks, assessing dogs and helping with the transport of dogs to their new homes. As a rescue, we also conduct follow up reviews and provide ongoing support and advice to all our rescue dogs and their adopters.


