THE ACTIVITIES HAVE HELPED THE TRUSTEES TO RELIEVE FINANCIAL HARDSHIP AMONG THE MOST NEEDY AND POOR PERSONS AND TO SUPPORT THE ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATION FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT.
