THE TRUSTEES SECURED DONATIONS OF £3,956 DURING THE YEAR WHICH WAS SIGNIFICANTLY LOWER THAN PREVIOUS YEAR (£26,172) DUE TO THE UNFORSEEN DEMISE OF THE FOUNDER OF THE CHARITY. DURING THE YEAR. THE EXPENDITURE FOR THE YEAR WAS £4,646 MAJORITY OF WHICH (£4,400) WERE GRANTS MADE TO SCHOOLS AND TO BENEFIT THE NEEDY PERSONS GLOBALLY. THE RESERVES OF £24,300 HAS BEEN KEPT FOR

FUTURE CHARITY EXPENDITURE AND LIABILITIES DUE IN THE COMING YEAR.

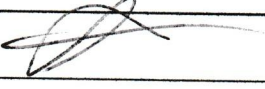

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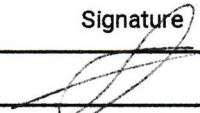
