Although a quiet year for fundraising Memorial donations from Martin's funeral reached nearly £2000. This was a mark of Martin's continued influence on the Trust. With the help of volunteers we sold books during the walking and book festival. We had a large number of applications and our grants made a difference to a much wider group of young people. This included youth services, riding for the disabled and young people who needed specialist equipment. We also continue to make an annual donation to Friedreichs Ataxia towards research. Drugs for treatment are currently awaiting approval for use in the UK.

Although it has been another year blighted by Covid19 the Charity has had a good year. We have been able because, of the kindness of Peter Thompson, to use his premises at 13 King Street, Richmond to fundraise. The shop will close at the end on 2021 and our target is to raise £20,000. We continue to have Public Liability Insurance in place to sell our second-hand books and paintings and hope to continue next year with our Sunday outdoor stall in the summer. If we can find a vacant shop we will also sell paintings again. Dowse and Son, Richmond have given us use of two storage units so our stock is safely stored. We have agreed to add Dowses as a sponsor on our new website in 2022.

Against the trend we have had a brilliant year for fundraising! Memorial donations from the funerals of June Bell and Frank Faulkner. The Book Stall was low key due to us having the use of 13 King Street. The shop raised £18193.28 up to end November 21. Business rates and other expenditure were a small price to pay. A Gift Aid claim will be submitted in 2022. A grant to Leyburn Town Council has been paid and two others are pending. New applications for play equipment are now closed. Hopefully when our website is up and running we will get more applications for grants. As we exceeded the Charity Commission low level we have had our accounts audited by Ian Crisop Accountancy.
