The objectives of the Trust remain unchanged, and our initial focus remains Nepal. We continue to conduct due diligence if selecting suitable charities that align with our objectives. By way of background information, the driving forces funding of the Trust have been from contributions from Gilham, Farlow and Innes and have not used Gift Aid nor have we sought contributions from other sources nor received any funds from the public or other sources.

Finally, we have taken the decision to seek professional support to ensure we comply with the fiduciary requirements of the Charity Commission.

Achievements and Performance

After the success of the ambitious and challenging Project OYAM, GIFT has taken time to focus on smaller projects, lending subject matter expertise and the benefit of lessons learned to other suitable charities which fit our objectives. This includes the potential renovation of a latrine facility in the vicinity of the Oyam Memorial Hall likely to be completed in Q2 of 2026. The trustees have been conducting research and socialising potential project ideas in expectation of a substantial donation in the next 18 – 24 months.

Financial Review

The Trust is expecting significant donations in the next 18 – 24 months which will allow us to refocus on a future project but in the short term we are generating a number of potential project ideas which will do the most good.

Structure, Governance and Management

The structure of the Trust is based on 6 Trustees including the Chairman. Trustees' meetings are held remotely and in person quarterly to discuss the charities longer term strategy in expectation of a guaranteed significant donation in the future.

By way of background information the driving force for funding of the Trust have been from contributions from Gilham, Farlow and Innes and have not used Gift Aid nor have we sought contributions from other sources nor received any funds from the public or other sources.

Finally, we have taken the decision to seek professional support to ensure we comply with the fiduciary requirements of the Charity Commission.

Achievements and Performance

Project OYAM, the challenging and ambitious extension to a school on east Nepal was completed and officially opened in May 2023. The build consists of a two storey Memorial Hall with a kitchen, dining areas, library, IT Suite and a segregated hostel for up to 50 students to stay at during the school week. We built the extension to withstand earthquakes with an option to build a 3rd floor. The interior facilities were an exercise in collaboration between multiple philanthropic organisations to broaden the school's facilities and its students' opportunities for generations to come. An extraordinary accomplishment, but we would be nowhere without the support, generosity and the expertise of our partners. Together we have paid back some of the "Debt of Honour" for the great sacrifice given unflinchingly and unquestioningly by the brave and loyal people of Nepal to the British Crown for over 200 years.

Financial Review

The Trust is expecting significant donations in the next 18 – 24 months which will allow us to refocus on a future project but in the short term we are collating lessons from Project OYAM to ensure the next project we undertake benefits from the challenges we faced during the design and build of the Memorial Hall.

Throughout this financial year we have made steady progress in our partnership with PTN UK, assisting administratively with the build and installation of a large extension to a school in a remote region of East Nepal. The land has been purchased using a combination of private donations and Municipality funding with retaining walls constructed to mitigate any subsidence. The project is expected to be finished in the second quarter of 2023.

The Trust has continued to be prudent in spending its funds as until the next major donation which we expect in the next year or so, the fund is not large and aspirations must be modest and we are content we have done sufficient research to make sound decisions for the future. No trips are planned to Nepal in the immediate future as we have sound contacts in place on the ground. A small number of visits to Nepal happened in 2022 but these were privately funded.

GIFT have been providing contacts and subject matter expertise to assist this other charity in building an extension, including hostel, library and IT suite to an existing school in Oyam. In spite of the increase in the cost of living and inflation of the cost of building materials and labour in Nepal, our partners are still on track to formally open the Oyam Memorial Hall on 1 May 2023.

The Trust has continued to be prudent in spending it's funds as until the next major donation, the fund is not large and aspirations must be modest and we are content we have done sufficient research to make sound decisions for the future. No trips are planned to Nepal in the immediate future as we have sound contacts in place on the ground. No visits were made to Nepal by Trustees in 2021-22 on related GIFT projects, a small number are in the early stages of planning for 2022-23 but these will be privately funded.
