The two charities share the same objects: The advancement of the religion of Islam and in particular of the Ahmadiyya Movement of Lahore as endorsed by Ahmadiyya Anjuman Lahore, Pakistan, and the relief of poverty.

AALF spends its income principally on the maintenance and management of its premises. The sister charity uses the premises to hold religious gatherings, meetings, talks and prayer functions, and to store its stock of books which are distributed to those enquiring about Islam and the Ahmadiyya Movement of Lahore. Details of the work of the sister charity are provided in the Annual report of that charity. That work is the joint work of both charities, and is overseen by AALF. To avoid duplication of reporting, all our activities are reported in the Annual report of AAIL(UK).

The following may be mentioned in connection with the work of AALF during this reporting period:

- In June 2025, a Transliteration-only edition of the Holy Quran was released, consisting of the Arabic text of the Quran represented in the English alphabet. This will enable those readers who cannot read Arabic to recite the text of the Quran.
- Also in June 2025, the revised, second edition of the *English Translation of The Holy Quran With Explanatory Notes — Language updated and notes abridged* (first published in 2010) was released.
- Both the above books were published on our website www.ahmadiyya.org, available for free download, and also made available for purchase in print from Amazon's print-on-demand service. The purchase price on Amazon is kept by us at the minimum, subject to the minimum price stipulated by Amazon.

The following may be mentioned in connection with the work of AALF during this reporting period:

- **Book publication:** A book *Islam and Antisemitism* was almost completed during the period of reporting (and was later published in September 2024). It aims to show that Islam does not teach hatred of Jews and in fact requires Muslim to respect their prophets to show sympathy to Jews in times of their need and persecution.
- **Berlin Mosque:** For the centenary of the Berlin Mosque and Mission of the Ahmadiyya Anjuman Lahore in Berlin, Germany, a donation of £500 was sent.
- **Collaboration and Resource Sharing Agreement:** A new, formal agreement was signed with our sister charity Ahmadiyya Anjuman Ishaat Islam Lahore (UK), granting it a licence to use the property 15 Stanley Avenue, Wembley.

- **Book publication** — *Sahih al-Bukhari*, English translation accompanied by explanatory notes translated from Maulana Muhammad Ali's Urdu work on Bukhari, *Faḍl al-Bārī*. This book of 800 pages was published as a print-on-demand book at Ingram Books in July 2022. It covers the first 2046 hadith reports out of the total 7563 hadith reports in Sahih Bukhari. It was also made available on Google Books for free download as a pdf document. It has become very popular due to being the only commentary in English on Bukhari.
- **Repair of building:** In the current financial year of AALF, a significant amount of funds were spent on essential building repairs to our Centre.

Religious functions, lectures and teaching

1. Our sister charity Ahmadiyya Anjuman Ishaat Islam Lahore (UK) uses the Centre at 15 Stanley Avenue, Wembley, owned by AALF, to carry out its charitable objectives. Due to the Coronavirus restrictions and precautions it was not possible to hold some of the usual religious functions and gatherings during the period of this report at 15 Stanley Avenue. Such gatherings were held through Zoom or YouTube live streaming, and were simultaneously broadcast on an Internet radio channel. After it became possible to hold functions at 15 Stanley Avenue, the online broadcasting was still continued and is now standard practice.
2. During Ramadan in April-May 2022, Dr Zahid Aziz produced his daily Quran Studies in text form, as he has done for several years, and these were circulated widely to Lahore Ahmadiyya community members internationally as well as to other interested Muslims. He also created video recordings of these Studies which were uploaded daily to a YouTube channel.
3. Eid-ul-Fitr on 2 May 2022 and Eid-ul-Adha on 9 July 2022 (this latter being just after the end of the period of this report) were the first major functions to be held at 15 Stanley Avenue since the lifting of the Coronavirus restrictions. These were well-attended and included non-Muslim guests. Social distancing was observed.

Maintenance of the Centre

While observing the precautions necessitated by Coronavirus, workmen continued to visit the Centre for maintenance, repair and renovation. Some window replacement work was done and the top floor flat in 15 Stanley Avenue was extensively renovated.

Literary work

1. The earlier 2019 publication, *English Translation of Sahih Bukhari, volume 1*, was reformatted in a larger page size (6 by 9 inches, 745 pages) and published through IngramSpark, as a print-on-demand book. As a result, it is available not only on Amazon but through other book retailers as well, such as Blackwells.

2. A previously online-only publication, *A Handbook of Islam*, was also revised and published through IngramSpark as a print-on-demand book.
3. Work was continued on revising and editing the section in *Muhammad in World Scriptures* (by Maulana Abdul Haq Vidyarthi) on Zoroastrian and Hindu scriptures.
4. Work continued on producing a new book, *Introduction to the Holy Quran*, which combines Maulana Muhammad Ali's book *Introduction to the Study of the Holy Quran* and his Introduction in his English Translation of the Holy Quran into one merged book.

Trustees' Annual Report for the Charity Commission for the year ending 30th June 2021

Religious functions, lectures and teaching

1. Our sister charity Ahmadiyya Anjuman Ishaat Islam Lahore (UK) uses the Centre at 15 Stanley Avenue, Wembley, owned by AALF, to carry out its charitable objectives. Since the Coronavirus restrictions were imposed in March 2020 (before our current year) it was not possible to hold any gatherings at 15 Stanley Avenue after the March monthly meeting. Consequently, during the year of this report, there were no monthly Sunday meetings, Friday prayers, Ramadan gatherings or Eid functions held at the Centre. All of these (except for Ramadan gatherings which did not take place) were regularly and fully conducted online by the AAAIL(UK). Prayers and sermons were transmitted by YouTube live streaming and Internet radio, while the monthly Sunday meetings were held through Zoom participation and live radio broadcasting of the meeting.
2. During Ramadan in April-May 2021, Dr Zahid Aziz produced his daily Quran Studies in text form, as he has done for several years, and these were circulated widely to Lahore Ahmadiyya community members internationally as well as to other interested Muslims. As last year, this year also a member in Holland recorded Dr Zahid Aziz on video reading out these studies, and uploaded them daily to a YouTube channel.

Maintenance of the Centre

Within the legal restrictions of the lockdowns, volunteers of the AAAIL(UK) continued to visit the Centre individually or in groups of two. These visits were for the purposes of maintenance of the Centre and to provide assistance to the resident house manager.

Literary work

The book *The Ahmadiyya Case of South Africa* was published online in March 2021 and also published on Amazon as a 'Print-on-Demand' book in March 2021. It is some 450 pages in length. Its first edition was published in 1987 as *The Ahmadiyya Case* and covered our court case and litigation in Cape Town during 1982–85, which resulted in the court judgment declaring Lahore Ahmadis to be Muslims. In producing the second edition, this book was carefully checked to improve the references given in it and some important material was added to it, including photographs relating to the case taken at that time.
