In addition, the County Chairman, Vice Chairman, Events and Marketing committee chair, Competitions Committee chair, Board of Management chair, President and 6 co-opted advisors, all elected or confirmed at the AGM, are also trustees.

Membership of the clubs associated within the Federation is open to all young people aged between 10 and 27. The trustees oversee the day to day running of the club through the Executive committee; trustees seek the views of members, the Federation's staff and volunteers in deciding the activities to be run. The Federation is affiliated to the National Federation of Young Farmers Clubs and also send representatives to the Board of Wales Federation of Young Farmers Clubs.

There is a Safeguarding Policy in place. Data Barring service checks are carried out prior to commencement of employment or trusteeship and checks carried out again in line with statutory requirements.

All trustees give their time voluntarily and receive no remuneration or other benefits as a result of their trusteeship.

There is a previously approved and declared familial relationship between one trustee and the sole paid member of staff. However, there are procedural checks and approvals in place to ensure that there can be no conflict of interest.

The organisation is in final stages of transferring its activities to a CIO in with the same name and objects (with Charity Number 1176227) and is awaiting transfer of the bank accounts for this to take place.

These include virtual Stockjudging and Virtual Carcass Judging competitions providing members with the opportunity to advance their knowledge and skills; public speaking, interview skills.

The County Youth Forum has grown in membership, giving a voice to younger members under 18.


