The trustees seek the views of other agencies working with the youth in deciding the activities to be run. There is a child protection and vulnerable adult policy in place. Disclosure checks are carried out prior to trusteeship and checks are carried out again in line with statutory requirements. KidsNLaw has been supported by the Warwickshire Education Authority Warwickshire Police and Crime Commissioner and Rugby Borough Council. But working in partnership with the schools and local youth organisations have been difficult and time consuming
All trustees give their time voluntarily and received no remuneration or other benefits
