Para 1.20	<p>During the year, the charity has successfully raised a further £48,591 to support its objectives of funding medical research projects focussed on Arrhythmogenic Cardiomyopathy, a heart muscle disease that affects young people.</p> <p>This means that the charity has raised almost £150,000 to achieve its objectives. After reaching an agreement with UCL in November 2020 to fund a project titled 'Disease Stratification in Arrhythmogenic Cardiomyopathy,' we were pleased to see the project commence as planned during 2021, for which the charity made a first tranche payment of £57,651.</p>


