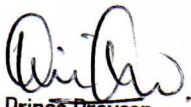

Independent Examiner's Report to the trustees of

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31st December 2020 set out on pages 7 and 8

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner:

Basis of the independent examiner's report:

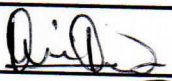
