Objectives and Activities

The Trust was set up following the death of Mr G A Hoines. The object of the trust is to apply the income to such charities, or for such charitable purposes, as the trustees think fit.

Achievements, Performance and Public Benefit

The trust makes grants to individuals and organisations. Grants have been paid out in the year amounting to £18,000 (2023 - £24,000).

The trustees consider that they have complied with the duty in section 4 of the Charities Act 2012 to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission.

Financial Review

The charity maintains sufficient free reserves to cover one year's management costs. Any surplus funds will be paid out by way of grants. Reserves as at the year end are £13,364 (2023 - £87,638).

The charity has sufficient funds to meet its liabilities.

None of the trustees received any remuneration or were reimbursed expenses.

Structure, Governance and Management

The charity is governed by a Declaration of Trust dated 8 January 2018. New trustees are appointed by the continuing and retiring trustees.

The trust was registered as a charity on 28 February 2018.
