The Trust is a charitable incorporated organisation formed using the foundation model dated 5 March 2018 and is registered as a Charity with Charity Commission for England and Wales under charity number 1177414.

Objects of the Charity

The principal objects of Sew Trust are:

- To relieve financial hardship, distress and suffering among poor people and other people in need by means of, but not exclusively, making grants or loans for providing or paying for items, equipment, services and facilities, including the provision of food, clean water and accommodation for the benefit of the said persons;
- To advance education for the benefit of the poor, the illiterate and the general public by means of, but not exclusively, the assistance in the provision of educational resources, equipment, activities and facilities, such as schools, libraries and training centres.

In planning activities, the trustees kept in mind the Charity Commissioner's guidance on public benefit at the meetings.

The charity provided funds by way of grants to construct a school in India.
