- continuing the Charity's partnership with the Amazon Smile programme, pursuant to which an Amazon customer can elect (at no extra cost) that Amazon donates 0.5% of their order price to the Charity - please note that Amazon has since discontinued this programme and the Charity Trustees do not anticipate receiving donations under this programme in future reporting periods.




- maintaining a fundraiser on the GoFundMe crowdfunding platform to collect donations and any related Gift Aid contributions (please note that this is also paid to the Charity via the PayPal Giving Fund);
- continuing the Charity's partnership with the Amazon Smile programme, pursuant to which an Amazon customer can elect (at no extra cost) that Amazon donates 0.5% of their order price to the Charity; and
- granting raised funds to the Visual Snow Global Research Fund, which is administered and distributed by the Visual Snow Initiative – an American public charity under the fiscal sponsorship of the Edwards Charles Foundation, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organisation – to key VS research teams across the world as and when it is needed.



