Para 1.20	<p>With an established worker in place, the trustees were able to oversee many positive developments. Our aim to help local schools with their collective worship and also develop partnership with others working in the sector is well demonstrated with the work we do with Good News for Everyone. We conducted assemblies and distributed New Testaments to year 7s. We also helped the same charity pilot RE resources in two schools for years 6 – 8. One of our trustees is part of the local Open the Book presentations into local primary schools, and so we can encourage this work too. We are slowly building up the pupils we can serve with the Transforming Loves for Good programme. Christmas is a great time to serve local schools. We provided digital daily material for class 'thought for the day' suitable for all ages. A class presentation of 'the smells of Christmas' was presented to 21 primary school classes and was so well received we have been asked to think of other similar presentations. Finally staff were remembered with gifts for the staff room for 25 schools. We continue to be part of the organisation of Pray for School Wales. In March 2024 our worker left us for a new fulltime role. This gave us the opportunity to assess our direction, write a new Job description, advertise and appoint for September 2024.</p>

Para 1.20	September 2022 saw the beginning of the first whole academic year for our worker. Funds came in, including a grant, which enabled us to continue to employ a person. This gave the charity the ability to plan for a whole cycle of events. Digital Freshers' material, Advent countdown and Lent meditations were well received by schools and individuals. Groups in schools, assemblies with the charity 'Good News for Everyone' and special events for year 7 pupils were all well received. Restarting work with TLG (Transforming Lives for Good) proved easier with the good church contact in Conwy than elsewhere. With our aim being to serve the local education community through and on behalf of the local church, we had to be creative in the way we did this. Schools were often closed and never able to welcome visitors. We opted to work in two ways, digitally and in practical service of support. Our trustees were able, because of their expertise, to support struggling students, and encourage tired staff. We also provided a number of chrome books to students who failed to qualify for the provision of these from other sources. Digitally we drew on the work of others and pointed schools to good provision for assemblies and curriculum items. Para 1.20	September 2019 – end of February 2020 were exciting days for C4E. Using the support of Transforming Lives for Good, one to one mentoring was established in 5 local schools. This led to a request for literacy assistance from one school and volunteers were found to deliver this. Partnering with Care for the Family we were able to assist in the delivery of parenting courses in 6 schools. College work continued with much time spent in one to one sessions with students or in tutorials. Assemblies were delivered in both primary and secondary schools, sometimes with local volunteers but also using invited guests such as The Message. March brought lockdown and a need to reassess what the charity could do. Supporting and encouraging teaching staff who faced a tremendous strain became our focus with messages, letters, ideas and prayers. This was much appreciated. As the year drew to a close we began to explore what the charity could do should lockdown continue and it was decided to concentrate on the need for support both mentally and physically through digital provision.
