When the charity was inaugurated in 2018, it was decided to focus our fundraising capacity on bringing in individual but regular donations, particularly from those people, based in the UK, who may also be registered for Gift Aid. These monthly donations are the charity's principal source of funding, and these amounts are transferred to Kenya on a regular basis.

Julie visited Kenya twice during 2024. During April, she supervised the completion of three new classrooms for Arc en Ciel Academy. The school will be ready to welcome Primary Grade 2 children in January 2025.

Julie was joined on her second visit by Zablon Mambo. Electricity was installed at the school. Zablon project managed the installation of a borehole giving much needed water to the local community.

We are also pleased to give the following updates:

- Two of the three additional girls (from 2023) remained with us joining the other twelve girls already in the rescue home.
- One girl begins her studies in Civil Engineering
- Two graduated from high school
- One girl continues at University studying Bachelor's in Education
- One girl enrolls in University studying Bachelor's in Nursing.

Julie visited Kenya twice during 2021; between 18th September 2020 and 28th January 2021 and then between 8th October and 15th November 2021,

This first visit was spent putting the finishing touches to the new rescue centre then moving and settling the girls and staff into their new accommodation.

In addition, a farm manager was employed during this time and was tasked with growing maize and taking care of a few livestock. This will help to offset some food costs in the future.

Julie spent her second visit monitoring and supervising the previous arrangements but also setting up and overseeing a schedule of care for the child with Cerebral Palsy. Part of this time was also spent looking for a suitable piece of land to further our project for 2022 which is that of building a nursery/kindergarten school.

When the charity was inaugurated in 2018, it was decided to focus our fundraising capacity on bringing in individual but regular donations, particularly from those people, based in the UK, who may also be registered for Gift Aid. These monthly donations are the charity's principal source of funding and these amounts are transferred to Kenya on a regular basis.

As well as individual donations, we also welcome one-off grants. A specific donation of £30,000 was made towards the end of 2019 for the purpose of building a rescue home for vulnerable girls. In 2020, a sum of £15,000 was added to this amount and the 3-bedroomed rescue centre with an additional two bed-roomed volunteer house and outdoor kitchen were completed and occupied during September 2020. This property is situated at Holo, close to Kisumu, Kenya.

Julie Hellon spent a total of five months in Kenya during 2020 and oversaw the completion of the houses. One return air travel ticket was covered by Association Kenyan Kids.

Zablon Mambo oversaw the purchase of the land, and project managed the buildings in their entirety.

Two girls were admitted to high schools in January 2020, having excelled in their Kenya Certificates of Primary Education.

Enfants Kenya held no fundraising events during 2020 due to Covid restrictions.
