The individual hub members hosted a few events in their academic year and national committee meetings were held to ensure any necessary support could be provided to them.

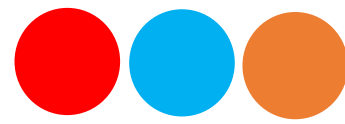

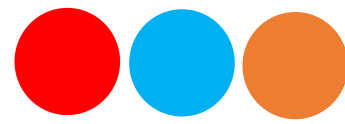

The charity has also paid for the website hosting including domain name (Wix) and a social media calendar (ContentCory). It also paid for Zoom Professional in June.

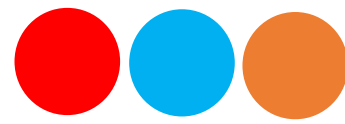

This financial year, majority of costs went onto the website and social media platforms as well as trustee planning meetings.

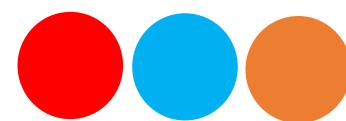

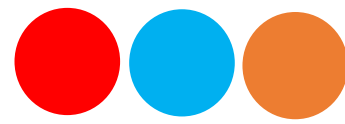
The charity also supports its branches financially if their application to the Trustee board is approved. The ACMA Southampton branch received monies totalling £60 to support their activities.
