Minutes of the Trustee Meeting.

Date: 14.06.2020 from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Present: Shiva Jamwal, Sunanda Padaruth, Anba Soopramanien (Chair), Kamachee Soopramanien (treasurer)

Agenda:

1. Situation to date: we discussed about the meetings of 14.12.19 and 15.01.20.
2. Finances: As at 14.06.2020, Neuram UK has a positive balance of £2704. Premavani Medical Ltd made a donation of £1000 end of May to Neuram UK. Veda donates by Direct Debit £100 each month.
3. Payment for Neuram website: we agreed that the fees of £1200 would be paid to Mr Andy Pohler (for work he did on the redesign of the Neuram Foundation website).
4. Fundraising: we would like to encourage members to fundraise as much as they can (e.g. the Ayacouty family organised a dinner in January 2020). Anba suggested subscribing to <http://trustfunding.org.uk/>. This is a source of Funding Trusts that specialise in funding charities, like ours. The cost of accessing their online database is £432 for one year for one user licence.
5. NEURAM UK meeting: we decided to organise a Neuram UK meeting on Saturday 20.06.2020 at 2 pm to discuss about the fundraising ideas, bring awareness on the issues regarding Neuram and define projects that could be funded.
6. Projects to be funded: in the wake of Covid 19, we could offer online support for people needing rehabilitation in Mauritius. Therefore, the project will be about telerehabilitation. This is one way of starting the mobile unit. The fund we will request would essentially be used towards training of the trainers and salaries for employing 3 physios, 3 OTs, 3 nurses and doctors locally. They would constitute a pool of clinicians working in the field of neurorehabilitation to provide support to patients. We will submit a draft business plan at the meeting on 20.06.20.
