DURING THE PERIOD, THE CHARTY SECURED INCOME OF £4,399 AND EXPENDED £11,229, WITH £11,000 IN GRANTS. THIS RESULTED IN A DEFICIT OF £6,830 WHICH WAS MET WITH PRIOR YEAR SURPLUSES. THE REMAINDER OF THE SURPLUS FUNDS OF £18,240 WILL BE RETAINED FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE IN THE COMING YEAR AND THE TRUSTEES HAVE A POLICY TO HOLD (FROM THE SURPLUS FUNDS) £2,000 IN GENERAL UNRESTRICTED FUNDS TO COVER ADMINISTRATION COSTS.

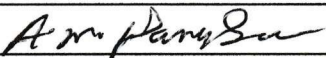
