To achieve the object and public benefit, the Trust has continued working in partnership with a number of local bodies such as the Duchy of Cornwall, Devon County Council, South Hams District Council, Dartmouth Town Council, Dart Harbour Authority, the Royal National Lifeboat Institution, South Devon and Channel Shellfishermen Ltd and local amateur sport clubs.


