Objectives and Activities

Malawi Student Foundation was established to support education projects in Malawi and to provide scholarships and grants to university students in the country. The Foundation targets students who are either at risk of dropping out of university due to financial difficulties or, despite having been selected, are unable to enrol because of poverty. In addition, the Foundation provides limited assistance to pupils at primary and secondary school level.

We confirm that the trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit. This guidance has been consulted when reviewing the Foundation's aims and objectives, planning future activities, and setting scholarship policy for the period.

Achievements and Performance

During the reporting period ended 31 December 2025, the Foundation awarded one new university scholarship and has provided support to a transformative primary school project aimed at improving Standard 8 results in the Ntonda area of Ntcheu District, Malawi.

This Standard 8 school performance support, in this instance, has been channelled through Abwenzi a Ntonda Ntcheu, an association of development-minded people who come from the Ntonda area of Ntcheu district in Malawi.

A total of eight university students from our first cohort successfully completed their degree programmes. The single scholarship awarded this year represents a tentative start to a new cohort, guided by available funding. Efforts are underway to encourage our graduates to become donors to the Foundation's education programmes, with a view to ensuring long-term sustainability.

The Foundation continues to meet its objectives, although more work is needed to raise funds for future cohorts.

Financial Review

The Foundation's work is entirely reliant on donations. During this reporting period, the Foundation raised £7,200. To maintain and sustain all project activities at an adequate level, the Foundation needs to raise at least £500 annually.

We are confident that the organisation will carry out its full functions during the next reporting period.



It is the Foundation's policy to maintain unrestricted funds, wherever possible, at a level of at least £500. The trustees consider that reserves at this level will enable the Foundation to continue its key basic activities while exploring ways to raise additional funds. At the year end, the Foundation held unrestricted funds of £807.

In 2026, the Foundation will continue to seek further funding from private donations. This will allow the Foundation to provide a respectable number of scholarships in Malawi and maintain its key project activities. The Foundation also plans to fund the Standard 8 Primary School Improvement project in Ntonda, Ntcheu, Malawi, which is regarded as transformative.

Structure, Governance and Management

Malawi Student Foundation is a registered Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), charity number 1179232, and is governed by a Constitution dated 26 March 2018.

Every appointed trustee must be appointed for a term of three years by a resolution passed at a properly convened meeting of the charity trustees. When selecting individuals for appointment, the charity trustees must have regard to the skills, knowledge, and experience needed for the effective administration of the CIO. All trustees were reappointed in 2024.

All trustees give their time freely, and no trustee remuneration was paid in the reporting period. Trustees are required to disclose all relevant interests and withdraw from decisions where a conflict of interest arises. Trustee Dr Manila Wisten is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Charity.

- 1 student at Mzuzu University
- 1 student at Malawi Polytechnic
- 1 student at Chancellor College

We are further pleased to report that three students (Maxwell Mpapa, Emmanuel Ngozo and Brighton Tseka) successfully completed their degrees during this period and became the first in their families to obtain a university education and degree. They are now all in various jobs at interim or permanent levels in Malawi.

This brings the total of successful university students on our programme to eight. None of our students dropped out of college during this period. The Foundation is satisfying its objectives, although more effort is required to support students achieve their potential.

Financial Review

The Foundation's work is entirely reliant on donations. For this reporting period the Foundation raised a total of £1,100 from unrestricted donations. In order to maintain and continue all of our project activities at a good level, the Foundation needs to raise at least £1,000 annually (new level).

We are confident that the organisation will carry out its full functions during the next reporting period.

It is the policy of the Foundation that unrestricted funds be maintained, wherever possible, at a level of at least £500. The Trustees consider that reserves at this level will ensure that the Foundation key basic activities while consideration is given to ways in which additional funds may be raised. At the year end the Foundation held unrestricted funds of £857.



In 2023 we will continue seeking to secure further funding from private donations, so that the Foundation can continue to provide a respectable number of scholarships in Malawi and therefore maintain its key project activities.

Structure, Governance and Management

All trustees were re-appointed in 2022.

Trustee, Dr Manila Wisten, is responsible for the day to day operations of the Charity.

Objectives and Activities

Malawi Student Foundation was established to provide scholarships and grants to students at universities in Malawi. These are students who are either in danger of dropping out of university because of financial difficulties or are unable to attend university in the first place, though selected, because of poverty. The Foundation also provides limited assistance to other students at high school level.

We confirm that the trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit. The trustees have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the Foundation's aims and objectives and in planning future activities and setting scholarship policy for the period.

Achievements and Performance

We are pleased that during the reporting period to 31 December 2021, Malawi Student Foundation provided scholarships to 5 students at various university bodies in Malawi covering university fees, laptops and monthly stipends as follows:

- 2 students at Malawi College of Medicine
- 1 student at Mzuzu University
- 1 student at Malawi Polytechnic
- 1 student at Chancellor College

We are further pleased to report that two students (Moses Kabanga and Christopher Chikazunga) successfully completed their degrees in medicine during this period and became the first in their families to obtain a university education and degree. The two new doctors are now working in government hospitals in Malawi.

This brings the total of successful university students on our programme to five. None of our students dropped out of college during this period. The Foundation is satisfying its objectives, but more effort is required to support students achieve their potential.

Financial Review

The Foundation's work is entirely reliant on donations. For this reporting period the Foundation raised a total of £6,200 from unrestricted donations. In order to maintain and continue all of our project activities at a good level, the Foundation needs to raise at least £2,000 annually (new level).

We are pleased to report that, for the next reporting period, funds have already been pledged to cover the minimum annual fund. We are therefore confident that the organisation will carry out its full functions during the next reporting period.

It is the policy of the Foundation that unrestricted funds be maintained, wherever possible, at a level of at least £500. The Trustees consider that reserves at this level will ensure that the Foundation key basic activities while consideration is given to ways in which additional funds may be raised. At the



year end the Foundation held unrestricted funds of £757.

In 2022 we will continue to seek to secure further funding from private donations, so that the Foundation can continue to provide a respectable number of scholarships in Malawi and therefore maintain its key project activities.
