

Grant funding remains the primary source for covering operational expenses, with the largest costs relating to residents, staff, and transport. Overall expenditure has decreased compared to the previous year, driven by improved purchasing practices and enhanced energy efficiency. We remain committed to strengthening cost controls and securing competitive pricing from suppliers to ensure financial sustainability.
