- Funds are also used in Pakistan to provide for homeless people in that country, all distribution of aid is monitored by trustees directly.

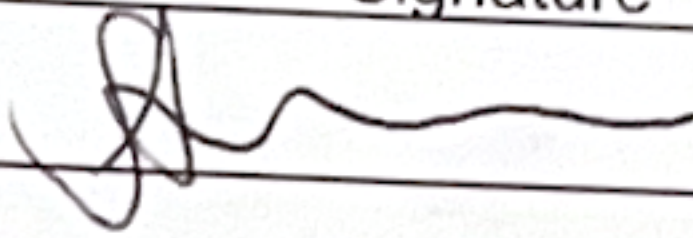
