Chairman's Report 2023-24

In the year 2023-24 we continued the technical restoration work on MCR21* and much was achieved with the help of our volunteers and donations from our supporters.

During the winter period we placed MCR21 into dry storage. This was successful from the storage point of view but as the other vehicles were tightly packed around it was not feasible to do work on MCR21. We have made up for this period during the rest of the year.

During the year we took MCR21 out to public display at several major public events:-

- ◆ Blackbushe "Air Day". Most of our volunteers attended and help to show and explain MCR21.
- ◆ The Camberley Car Show was another successful event, free to attend in the town centre.
- ◆ Several "fundraising events" were undertaken, notably with the support of the BVWS*

We are continuing our fundraising programme, and we continue to receive increasing numbers of regular donations, which will be used to maintain MCR21 and our other projects. On behalf of the Trust, I would like to express our thanks to all these donors.

We are making efforts to find a suitable "home" for MCR21 and the other items in our care. As part of this we are making plans to establish a "Reference Library." This will list and preserve important technical documents and books making them available for visiting researchers.

We have established three websites that show details of our work. In addition, we have made many detailed video recordings to highlight different aspects of the restoration and repair processes.

Our financial projections for income and expenditure for future years continue to look sufficient for the planned work.

Chairman's Report 2022-23

In the year 2022-23 we completed our Heritage Lottery Grant and the final payment has been received. We met in full the requirements of the HLF and good relationships continued throughout.

This was a busy year and we took MCR21 to several major public events:-

- A week at the Amberley chalk Pits Museum where we held a reception for ex BBC staff.
- A single day at Wimbledon Tennis where MCR21 featured in the BBC's review of Wimbledon's history. We were also visited by the BBC's Director general Tim Davies. It is interesting to note that MCR21 was working at Wimbledon just 58 years earlier.
- Three days outside the BBC's New Broadcasting House headquarters in London where it featured on the 7pm "One Show"
- Other days at the Royal Holloway College, the Guild of Television Professionals and the local Camberley Car Show.

Work continued on the restoration work particularly the technical installation, although much remains to be done. I would like to put on record our thanks for the huge contributions to this work from our team of volunteers.

We have started a fundraising programme, and we are pleased to be receiving a number of donations which will help secure our future. On behalf of the Trust I would like to express our thanks to those donors.

Our financial situation is healthy, with a solid reserve and donation income matching carefully managed expenditure.



Chairman's Report 2021-22

During the early months of 2021 work continued to get MCR21 ready for its first public exhibition at the Goodwood Revival in September. Major items were the refitting of the teak roof planking, the building of the monitor stack fascia, supports and the installation of 7 monitors that allowed us to play a demonstration recording to explain the operation of a "mobile control room"

This operational simulation programme was written by one of our volunteers who programmed a group of Raspberry Pi computers to perform this function. Another volunteer built a case to house them and installed them. This display forms the main part of our demonstrations of an OB van in action.

There were many small steps forward in the restoration and some larger ones. The professional signwriting in the traditional way was one and the fitting of the chrome front and rear bumpers another. This turned out to be a bit of an epic and the extra cost was funded by a donation from one of our supporters.

This was all in place for our major Goodwood Revival event, which drew huge interest.

In October we attended the British Vintage Wireless Society "Retrotech" exhibition with our display stands, but it was too far for MCR21 itself to attend.

During the winter period work continued on the interior. The wooden structures and ducting in the front engineering zone were started and this enabled the installation of the "mains distribution panel" and wiring.

We have maintained our good relationship with the Heritage Lottery Fund, and we are on course to receive the final payment at the end of the project.

Our group of supporters, and volunteers for the restoration work continue to grow and there is a far wider level of public awareness, reflecting continued enthusiasm for the restoration of MCR21.

We have Plans for several "MCR21 Events" during the coming summer to coincide with the completion of our HLF grant.

Chairman's Report 2020-21

Despite the major constraints of the Covid pandemic and the resultant lockdowns, we have managed to maintain a good momentum on the project during the year, with an increased volunteer group and regular work sessions on the BBC Outside Broadcast vehicle MCR21.

The mechanical restoration work at Ward Jones Ltd was finally completed in February and the vehicle was returned to its base in Camberley for final exterior work and the start of the major interior fit-out. The vehicle is now mechanically sound, driveable and has been re-painted in the correct 1963 BBC livery.

The remaining volunteer activities in the year have included lighting and power re-wiring, finishing of lockers, bumpers and other external parts, and a major effort on cleaning the interior. Other volunteers have been working on equipment refurbishment, website and social media material and video documentation of the project.

Covid constraints inevitably prevented all our planned attendance at schools, museums and public events.

Our next stage funding from the Heritage Fund (c. £39K) was approved and paid, following a project stage report. In addition, a successful application to the Garfield Weston Foundation resulted in a £2K grant. Donations and equipment sales have boosted our fund-raising by a further £4K.

We have finished the year with a far larger group of supporters, more volunteers for the restoration work, and a far wider level of public awareness, reflecting continued enthusiasm for the restoration of MCR21.

We have been invited to attend the Goodwood Revival in September 2021. This will be a major project milestone, and the first public outing for the newly-restored vehicle.
