Report by the Chairman of Trustees for the Annual Return 2025

The Charity was incorporated in 2018 with the primary objective of advancing the Christian faith in the United Kingdom and abroad. Since then Tim Grant, the Ministry Director, has fulfilled this objective by teaching and preaching in this country and further afield, working with the leaders of the churches and networks he serves, using established relationships and making new contacts.

In February 2025, arrangements for the sale of our two tents and associated equipment to another charity were concluded and an Agreement was signed, providing for the price of £15,000 to be paid by monthly instalments of £500. This marked the end of many years of tent ministry, in the UK and throughout Europe, which has seen the gospel preached and many come to know Jesus Christ as their personal saviour.

During the year, Tim has travelled widely in this country and abroad in the course of his ministry. He has continued to build new relationships in the north west of England where he lives, working with individual churches and networks, at evangelistic events and a biblical training school. He has taught on healing and been involved in evangelism at churches in Hampshire, as well as ministering at events in Scotland and Wales. He has been to Belarus, speaking at a conference for evangelists from Eastern Europe, and Bulgaria, ministering once again to both gypsy and Bulgarian churches. A new opportunity was a trip to Estonia, where he spoke in churches and at a conference on moving in the power of the Holy Spirit. Another trip is planned for next year, which would include teaching and also evangelism.

This year has been a year of change, with the letting go of the tents and all that was involved in running tent events, and the development of a new thrust, equipping churches at home and abroad to reach out into their communities in the power of the Holy Spirit. Tim believes the training should be made available on video so as to be more widely accessible.

The Trustees have met in person once this year but have communicated at other times via phone and email to discuss the work of the Charity and its finances, especially the sale of the tents, which has significantly increased our income. This gives us the opportunity to increase our expenditure to support the development of the Charity's work.

Report by the Chairman of Trustees for the Annual Return 2024

The Charity was incorporated in 2018 with the primary objective of advancing the Christian faith in the United Kingdom and abroad. Since then Tim Grant, the Ministry Director, has fulfilled this objective by teaching and preaching in this country and further afield, in person and online, working with the leaders of the groups he serves using established relationships and making new contacts.

As mentioned in last year's report, Tim's wife Kim (who was the Associate Director) died in April 2023. Her absence is still keenly felt but in 2024 Tim resumed a number of ministry activities, including his involvement in a series of teaching conferences in Bulgaria. In this country, he continues to teach and preach at various venues. For some of these, he uses material from courses he established some years ago, such as 'School of Evangelism' and 'School of Faith'.

The Trustees have met in person twice during the year and have communicated at other times via email when necessary to discuss the work and finances of the Charity. Its income and expenditure have once again been modest, with a deficit of £22 meaning that the balance of funds held at the end of the financial year remained at just over £7,200.

Report by the Chairman of Trustees for the Annual Return 2023

The Charity was incorporated in 2018 with the primary objective of advancing the Christian faith in the United Kingdom and abroad. Since then Tim Grant, the Ministry Director, and his wife Kim, the Associate Director, have fulfilled this objective by teaching and preaching in this country and further afield, in person and online, working with the leaders of the groups they serve, utilising established relationships and making new contacts.

2023 was overshadowed by Kim's declining health. She had taken an active role in the work of Spearhead and in supporting Tim, as well as using her gifts and life experience in her own ministry. She died in April and there was a service in May to celebrate her life. The number of people who attended was testament to the influence she had and the blessing she has been for so many. Inevitably, Tim took time out from his ministry following her death, but towards the end of the year he began to re-connect with his existing contacts and consider new ventures.

For the same reason, the Trustees did not meet regularly during the year but gave Tim the space he needed, while keeping in touch with each other and monitoring the Charity's finances. Although its income and expenditure continued to be modest, its General Funds increased by £1,732, mainly due to an increase in donations.

Report by the Chairman of Trustees for the Annual Return 2022

The Charity was incorporated in 2018 with the primary objective of advancing the Christian faith in the United Kingdom and abroad. Tim Grant, the Ministry Director, and his wife Kim, the Associate Director, have continued to fulfil this objective by teaching and preaching both in this country and further afield, following the relaxation of the COVID-19 restrictions. They are supported but not employed by the Charity and they work with the leaders of the groups they serve, utilising both established relationships and new contacts.

Although part of Tim and Kim's ministry continues to be online, in 2022 they have also been able to visit churches and attend events in person. The second North West Evangelists Conference was held in March and Tim taught at one of the seminars. In June, Tim went to Bulgaria with a team from a Liverpool church, to encourage and minister to church leaders there. July was a particularly busy month, with events in Oxford (involving the smaller of Spearhead's two tents) and London before Tim travelled to Norway to speak at a week-long conference. On his return, he and Kim were involved in a three day evangelistic event in Liverpool. They then headed north to take part in the last of six events in Scotland with a team from another church in Liverpool. At both events, they worked with evangelists from around the country and saw many people make a commitment to Christ.

Once again, the Trustees have met three times in the course of the year to review the work of the Charity and monitor its finances. Although the Charity's income and expenditure have remained modest, there was a small increase in General Funds. We hope to welcome one if not two new faces to the Trustees in 2023.

Report by the Chairman of Trustees for the Annual Return 2021

The Charity was incorporated in 2018 with the primary objective of advancing the Christian faith in the United Kingdom and abroad. Tim Grant, the Ministry Director, and his wife Kim, the Associate Director, have continued to fulfil this objective by serving churches and other Christian groups but due to the restrictions arising from the COVID -19 pandemic, they have not been able to travel overseas in 2021. They are supported but not employed by the Charity and they work with the leaders of the groups they serve, utilising both established relationships and new contacts.

The pandemic meant that Tim and Kim had to adapt their ministry. They have continued to teach and preach online. The charity's website has been rebuilt and its mailing facilities have been improved. Tim helped organise the North West Evangelists Conference in September and another may be held in 2022. He has been very well received since moving to Liverpool and is considering a Spearhead event in the city next year. Tent missions have not been possible in 2021 due to the pandemic but there has been a lot of interest in them recently and, restrictions permitting, a number are being planned around the country for next year.

For their part, the Trustees have met three times in 2021 to review the work of the Charity and monitor its finances. Once again, both the income of the Charity and its expenditure have been modest but as before, we do not intend to engage in fundraising as we believe that the work of the Charity will be supported by those who catch and share its vision, including those who benefit from its ministry.
