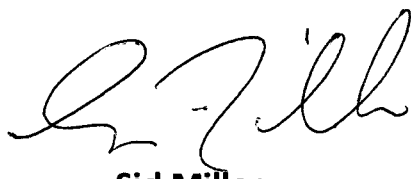
Report for the year

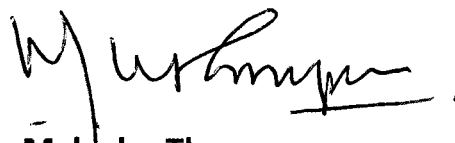
