- Trustee must be free of criminal record, fraudulent activities, and must work in the best interest of Thousands . Buddha UK charity
- Trustees failing to meet these standards should be allowed to resign voluntarily or will be asked to do so by other trustees.
- Trustee nomination should be put before the Trustees, who will then put forward suitable candidates before the Annual General Meeting to approve.

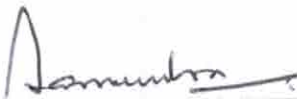
Objectives and activities
