We operate in the borough of Slough and Farnborough; where Christians from different countries and background come together to praise God, and discover more of Jesus' love in their lives.

Our ministries are devoted to serving people of all ages, backgrounds and cultures; establishing a safe space for the homeless, elderly, families and the young. As a Christian charity, we primarily strive to build courage in those living in desperate poverty; encouraging all those in hopeless circumstances to focus their hope in God, as opposed to uncertainty, instability and fear of the future. We envision to see God glorified through the faith and love we share to those who are left vulnerable by poverty, giving them hope and a future in Christ.

The ways in which we support and build a greater integrated community of people would include the following:

- Share the gospel and the love of God; teaching Christian core values based on the Bible
- Conduct worship, communion and baptism services on a regular basis and festive services during Easter, Christmas and New Year
- Carry out weekly prayer group sessions, Bible study and social connections; aspiring to strengthen the spiritual and emotional well-being of communities, creating a sense of belonging
- Equip, support, motivate and mentor children and youth by carrying out Bible lessons, programs and social connections. We foster creative and interactive learning, unlocking their true potential to make a significant difference in families, communities and generations to come
- Provide teaching resources in linguistic skills; primarily in the Tamil language, up to GCSE level
- Connect with churches across the UK and other countries; inspiring all denominations to work together in unity
- Work in partnership with Compassion UK ([www.compassionuk.org](http://www.compassionuk.org)) and sponsor children in regions of Sri Lanka, Indonesia and Guatemala; giving them life-changing support. This includes food, education, health-checks and the care of local churches.

**Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner**


