Para 1.20	<p>Due to the ongoing impacts of the Covid19 Pandemic the trustees were unable to make visits to inspect the work carried out. The trustees kept in touch with the Partners remotely using electronic means. The key partners were in the UK for the early part of the year when we met with them formally and informally to discuss past and future plans.</p> <p>The water tank project will provide secure hygienic bulk water storage for the village, this will enable the villagers to spend less time collecting water and thereby release them to other employment and income generating opportunities.</p> <p>The emergency relief fund enabled our partners to respond to needs as they arise in the community.</p> <p>The Family Education Project expanded the remit of the Schools Sponsorship to allow it to support the family to ensure the children can remain in education. The distribution of School Clothing, Equipment and Fees was carried out at the start of the New School Year after the Dashain Festival in October.</p> <p>With the constraints of Covid19 we were able to fund raise by :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monthly and annual gifts • Trustee fund raising initiatives. • One trustee was able to do an organised sponsored event • A Grant was received from St Paul's Howell Hill

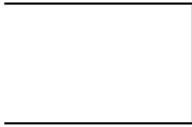
