Financial Review

For the year to 30th April 2025, funds were raised of £54,969 greatly increased on last year, allowing for the necessary charity expenses and farm repairs, leaving a net surplus of £36,820.
The trust reserves remain in a good financial position, being improved on last year's reserves at £58,796. Adequate reserves are held for the ongoing costs and maintenance of the farm.
