## **ANNUAL REPORT -YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 2024**

The City of Hull Street Angels have continued to be a valued and much-loved presence in Hull city centre this year. Our band of volunteers have supported the nighttime economy almost every Friday & Saturday night throughout the past 12 months. We are the only group of street angels operating in Hull and our commitment is recognised by the emergency services and the public alike.

We have moved our base again to Trinity House Chambers, this is much closer to the area we tend to work within and allows our volunteers much easier access to facilities. We must thank the board of Hull Trinity House Charity for their benevolence. Thanks also to Carole Fenny for her work in finding us these premises and to the other volunteers who have helped make the base more comfortable. Carole has now retired from her role as a trustee, and we wish her well in her future endeavours.

Our trustees continue to work behind the scenes and particular mention must go to Jamie Lewis, our Chair, through his knowledge we have been able to attract more funding this year. We received £5000 from the Matthew Good Foundation and over £2500 was raised from the Women in Business lunch. We had donations from T J Smith & Nephew (£1000) and Life for a Kid (£500). Michelle Ditchburn once again supported us with a donation of £500. The general public also give generously to our street angels when we are out supporting them at the weekends and at various events we have attended. The City of Hull Street Angels were once again at the Hull Pride event providing assistance during the day and well into the evening and the early hours of the following morning.

We like to support our volunteers, and we held a Christmas party event locally as a thank you. We also had a table at the Time 2

Volunteer awards and the Hull Women in Business events held at the Double Tree Hilton. We value the time and effort our volunteers give and we will continue supporting them as without them our charity would not exist.

We have welcomed several new Street Angels this year and said farewell to others. Some have stepped back for a short time but assure us they will be back. Family commitments, illness and work challenges do get in the way and we thank you all. We have become a stepping stone for some to move on into their future careers, the emergency services seem to like recruits who have volunteered with us.

Moving forward into our next year we shall be focusing on further recruitment of new volunteers and offering more training opportunities to everyone. We hope to increase our social media presence in order to make people more aware of our activities.

### **SEPTEMBER 2023**

Another successful year for the City of Hull Street Angels continuing to support the nighttime economy in Hull City Centre. We have welcomed a new Chair – Jamie Lewis. His experience and insight have enabled us to move forward, through him we relocated our base from Atik to 161 High Street. Although we have been grateful to Atik for allowing us to use one of their rooms for a base it was nice to have our own self-contained premises. This has allowed our volunteers to get changed and have a break and refreshments before during and after their shifts. We welcomed several new volunteers and others left having given great service to the organisation. We wish them well in their future roles.

We are now the only Street Angels operating in the city centre as Hull Street Angels Trinity decided to close down their activities.

We continue to receive welcome donations from our supporters, but revenue is significantly less than last year. We were unable to have as many fundraising events as last year but grants from Two Ridings and Help for Health have really helped. Private donations were also received, in particular from Michelle Ditchburn.

Our expenses increased this year, our bus being one of the main costs. Due to not having volunteers able to drive the bus it was left standing, and lack of use brought several faults to a head. It has now been sold as running costs were becoming prohibitive. We committed funds to training and replacing jackets and equipment.

We end the financial year still on a healthy footing and look forward to another year of 'Angeling.'

### **SEPTEMBER 2022**

A year in which the City of Hull Street Angels were able to continue supporting the nighttime economy of Hull City Centre. We welcomed new volunteers to our ranks and said farewell to others who had served us well. Two of our founder trustees – Tess Ellerington & Steve Taylor left to pursue other activities but remain loyal supporters.

We were pleased to support Hull Pride and provided support at the annual event – our support bus was sited in the midst of the entertainment in Queen’s Gardens and was well received by the crowds. We were able to raise funds there too by holding one of our amazing tombolas.

Our fundraising met new heights especially from the Golf Day we were able to have at Ganstead Golf Club – we raised over £2000 at that event alone. We also received our share of the Lord Mayor’s Charity - £6053. These two amounts have boosted our bank balance and have enabled us to do further training with our volunteers.

We are committed to making sure our volunteers are supported and trained and have provided courses throughout the year.

We were once again supported by ARCO – one of their staff Rebecca Kirby was sadly killed in a road accident in Hull city centre and our Street Angels attended the scene. Arco staff had a collection which was matched by their company – we received over £700 from them. Becky’s family have also donated to us personally. We have purchased defibrillators – 1 portable and the others situated around the city centre. We are awaiting approval from the City Council for permission to site one in Whitefriargate.

KCom kindly gave us a donation of £400 from their community support programme.

The people of Hull continue to ‘love’ the Street Angels and this is shown in their generosity towards us. We regularly received donations when out on patrol. Kay Somers – our No.1 Street Angel regularly collects this money for passing on to our treasurer.

We approach the next year with a healthy bank balance and smiling faces. Thank you to everyone who has supported us in whatever way, without this support we would not be able to function as we do.

Another difficult year for the Street Angels due to the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic. We were only able to operate in limited circumstances but when and wherever we could we were there. Our amazing volunteers and supporters continue to keep us going.

We purchased our 'new' bus, and this was only due to the fantastic support we received from Arco with their very generous donation of £3000. The bus was wrapped by Vinyl FX for free, again a very much appreciated gesture.

We were delighted to be one of the Lord Mayors Charities and we must thank Mrs. Lyn Petrini for all her help in helping us achieve further recognition in the city. Volunteers and Trustees attended various fundraising events and will continue to do so during the period of the Lord Mayor being in office (this was extended due to the pandemic).

We registered with HMRC for Gift Aid, and this saw a payment of over £1700 which has helped cover the ongoing costs involved with the charity.

The public are still supportive of us, and many cash donations are given for flip flops, water etc. whilst the street angels are out on patrol.

We also received £500 from a lady who raises funds for charities by selling unwanted items from her home.

The Neighbourhood Network gave us £300 which we used to buy chairs and the awning for the bus.

We face the next budget year with renewed optimism and with the hope that we may be seeing an end to the struggles we have all faced with the pandemic.

Thank you to all our wonderful volunteers for your unstinting work and thank you to all the people who have supported our charity in their numerous ways.
