MEMBERS DO NOT NECESSARILY HAVE TO BOWL, THEY CAN JUST SIMPLY SOCIALISE OR INDEED HELP WITH THE GENERAL CLUB ACTIVITIES AND BE SOCIAL MEMBERS. THIS YEAR WE HAVE INCREASED OUR MEMBERSHIP BY TWELVE, THIS IS VERY GOOD FOR A SMALL CLUB. SOME LOCAL CLUBS HAVE HAD TO CLOSE HAVE ACTUALLY CLOSED AS A RESULT OF THE LOCAL COUNCIL NOT SUPPORTING BOWLING . AS A RESULT WE NOW HAVE A LADIES TEAM WHICH COMPLETES IN THE LOCAL LEAGUE.
