In 2021 the clock on the church tower failed due to a broken part and that was repaired and serviced and it is now functioning well.
Christmas cards were printed and sold to raise funds.
In 2022 the church organ was repaired and badges were designed and ordered for sale to the public.
In 2023 funds were raised to improve the kitchen facilities in the Church centre.
In 2024 a dishwasher was provided for the Church Centre.
In 2025 a wide screen television was provided for the benefit of the public in both the church and church centre.
