Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 5 April 2025

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 5 April 2025. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

Through its wholly owned subsidiary, Ark House Rehab Ltd, the EA & W Muxlow Charitable Trust offers an affordable and effective residential rehabilitation programme for alcoholics and mother addicts. Its programme is based on the 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous. Ark House Rehab Limited takes self-funding clients alongside clients funded by Local Authority Services and also provides free places for alcoholics and addicts for whom no other funding is available, if they are assessed as ready for rehab.

Significant activities

Four years ago the Charity acquired Ark House Rehab Limited (a CQC registered rehab facility) in Scarborough as an investment/trading subsidiary that fits exactly with the Charity's primary objectives and charitable activities as described above. During the year 2022/23 the CQC rating for Ark House Rehab Limited was uprated to "Good". Throughout the year we have continued to support many alcoholics and addicts in line with our stated objectives. We also provide a family programme offering support to family members of those in the Rehab. Following the purchase of the freehold of the Rehab building and land two years ago, the property and its facilities have undergone a significant programme of repair and improvement.

Public benefit

We have referred to guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aims and objectives and in planning our future activities.

The public benefit of our activities is clear. We assist alcoholics and drug addicts (for whom no other funding is available) to recover from their disease and lead productive and rewarding lives. This benefits the individuals their families, friends, employers and mitigates the cost to wider society. We have referred to guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aims and objectives and in planning our future activities.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Fundraising activities

To date we have not undertaken fund raising activities as such, 'though in the year being reported we received generous donations from the 2024 Yorkshire Clay Days fundraising event at Duncombe Park Helmsley and at Wykeham Abbey and from a family trust. We are planning to fundraise going forwards having obtained the Charity Commission's consent to adopt "Ark House Rehab" as a working name for the Charity.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The Charity's income during the year was £103,451 made up of investment income of £4,654 and donations of £98,797.

Any revaluation gains are non distributable reserves.

Reserves policy

The trustees have resolved to build a financial reserve of £200,000 across the charity and its subsidiary.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

During the year 2024/25 Sara Maya Al-Askari retired as a trustee. The Power to appoint new or replacement trustees is vested in the Settlor. The trustees meet periodically in person and/or via Zoom and are in regular contact by email and telephone.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value, as modified by the revaluation of certain assets.

Income

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Investment property

Investment property is shown at most recent valuation. Any aggregate surplus or deficit arising from changes in fair value is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 5 April 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The EA & W Muxlow Charitable Trust has continued to fund rehabilitation for alcoholics and addicts for whom no other funding (private or through Local Authority Services) was available, in cases where the alcoholic or addict has been assessed as suitable for and has agreed to undertake a 12 Step programme of rehabilitation. Where necessary we have also funded medical detox prior to admission to a Rehab facility.

Significant activities

As reported last year In November 2021 the Charity acquired Ark House Rehab Limited (a CQC registered rehab facility) in Scarborough as an investment/trading subsidiary that fits exactly with the Charity's primary objectives and charitable activities as described above. During the year the CQC rating for Ark House Rehab Limited has been uprated to "Good". Throughout the year we have continued to support many alcoholics and addicts in line with our stated objectives and aims. We also authorised our wholly owned subsidiary (Ark House Rehab Limited) to purchase the freehold of the Rehab premises at 15 Valley Road Scarborough and to pursue the maintenance and improvement of the property and of the client accommodation and facilities.

Public benefit

We have referred to guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aims and objectives and in planning our future activities.

The public benefit of our activities is clear. We assist alcoholics and drug addicts (for whom no other funding is available) to recover from their disease and lead productive and rewarding lives. This benefits the individuals their families, friends, employers and mitigates the cost to wider society. We have referred to guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aims and objectives and in planning our future activities.

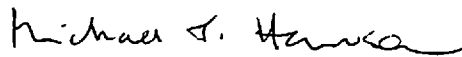

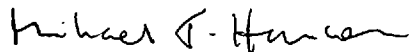

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 5 April 2022

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 5 April 2022. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The EA & W Muxlow Charitable Trust has continued to fund rehabilitation for alcoholics and addicts for whom no other funding (private or through Local Authority Services) was available, in cases where the alcoholic has been assessed as suitable for and has agreed to undertake a 12 Step programme of rehabilitation. Where absolutely necessary we have also funded medical detox prior to admission to a Rehab facility.

Significant activities

In November 2021 the Charity acquired Ark House Rehab Limited (a CQC registered rehab facility) in Scarborough as an investment/trading subsidiary that fits exactly with the Charity's primary objectives and charitable activities as described above. The trustees believe that this investment will increase the number of alcoholics and addicts who can benefit from a 12 Step Recovery Programme in a safe and professional environment. The public benefit of our activities is clear. We assist alcoholics and drug addicts (for whom no other funding is available) to recover from their disease and lead productive and rewarding lives. This benefits the individuals their families, friends, employers and mitigates the cost to wider society

Public benefit

We have referred to guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aims and objectives and in planning our future activities.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Fundraising activities

To date we have not undertaken fund raising activities as such, 'though in the year to 5 April 2022 we have received generous overseas donations from relatives and friends of one of the trustees. We are planning to fundraise going forwards and have obtained the Charity Commission's consent to adopt "Ark House Rehab" as a working name for the Charity

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The Charity's income during the year was £36,557.00 made up of investment income of £1,435 and Donations totalling £34,307. During the same period the Charity has expended £40,956 in funding rehab or detox for alcoholics or drug addicts.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

There has been no retirement or appointment of trustees during the year 2021/22. The Power to appoint new or replacement trustees is vested in the Settlor. The trustees meet periodically in person and/or via Zoom, and are in regular contact by email and telephone.

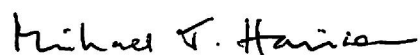
