Annual Report for the financial year ended 30th June 2025

Whalley and District Lions continue to hold various functions throughout the year to raise charitable funds. These were donated to charity causes both in the local community, national and internationally.

Whalley Day now in its 4th year is held during Heritage Open Weekend in September. It is a traditional event with stalls, food, entertainment and games. Local groups including churches are also involved with the aim of bringing the whole community together. The event raised £2,142 after expenses.

Donations made totalled £2,374 in the financial year ; including £518 for a Bleed Control Kit, £200 to Whalley Methodist Church, £250 to Derian House Children's Hospice, £250 to Whalley Abbey, £500 towards the purchase of a Sight Camera, £100 to The Foundation for Ribble Valley Families charity, £100 to Ribble Valley Strength in Struggles charity and £196 worth of food for the Ribble Valley Food Bank Christmas appeal. An international donation was made to Lions Clubs International Foundation of £260 for domestic ovens for displaced people in Ukraine.

Volunteer members supported Whalley in Bloom, The Flood Action Group, and Clitheroe Food Festival. The Club was also involved with the National Garden Scheme weekend which took place in Whalley and the surrounding area.

We continue to organise Easter events for children, an afternoon tea and Christmas meal for our local older residents, village clean ups and monthly coffee mornings. This year we also acquired an allotment. The club continues to collect spectacles and pill blister packs for recycling and continues to distribute Lions Message in a Bottle program.

The charity account total income of £14,849 includes £8,895 donation received from Whalley Flood Action Group when it disbanded and the rest of the income was raised through Whalley Day (mentioned above), grants/donations, book sales, coffee mornings and street collections.

The club account total income of £4,946 is from membership fees and events identified as non-charitable. The membership fees were used to pay membership subscriptions to Lions District/Multi District and International.

Annual Report for the financial year ended 30th June 2024

Whalley and District Lions continue to hold various functions throughout the year to raise charitable funds. These were donated to worthy causes both in the local community, nationally and internationally.

Whalley Day which is now in its third year is held during the Heritage Open Days Weekend. The event, held at Whalley Abbey is a celebration of village life with local businesses, churches, youth groups and community groups all enjoying a day of craft stalls, games, entertainment and food. The event raised £1,442 after expenses for the charity account.

Donations from Whalley Lions to other charities, groups and individuals included Burnley Boys and Girls Club £300, Lead Exposure Elimination Project £100, Macular Society and The Samaritans £130, Music and Wellbeing Project £100, Texas floods £100, Taipei earthquake £100 and Friends of Whalley Moor Woodland £100. A young, disadvantaged ballerina from Whalley was given a donation of £100 to attend ballet school and £250 was donated to children visiting from Ukraine. Donations were also given to the Ribble Valley Food Bank, Salvation Army and Child Action North West.

Members through volunteering their time also supported Whalley in Bloom, the Flood Action Group and Clitheroe Food Festival. We continue to organise monthly village clean ups, hold free coffee mornings, glean surplus fruit, organise an Easter Treasure Hunt for children and a lunch and Christmas meal for our local older residents.

The charity account total income of £4,242 was raised through Whalley Day (as above), donations, book sales, coffee mornings and street collections.

The club account total income of £4,605 is from membership fees and events identified as non-charitable. The fees are used to pay membership subscriptions to Lions District/Multi District and International.

Annual Report for the financial year ended 30th June 2023

Whalley and District Lions held various functions throughout the year to raise charitable funds. These were donated to worthy causes both in the local community, nationally and internationally.

A concert and auction raised £5,525 for the North West Air Ambulance charities and donations were made to charities, not for profit and community good causes from events organised by our Members. These included £200 for an Osmosis water kit for Ukraine, £150 to Marie Curie, £250 to Brain Tumour Research, £140 to Riding for the Disabled, £500 to Ribble Valley Food Bank and £150 for the restoration of the bell tower at the Parish Church of St Mary and All Saints Whalley. Emergency welfare was also given to support local families in need.

A free coffee morning is held every month for residents of Whalley and the surrounding district at Whalley Methodist church and advice and support is available from Lion members if required.

Whalley and District Lions club has also worked in partnership with the Flood Action Group for several years. The Flood Account has income £0 and expenditure £224 in the year.

Our Members organised village clean ups, supported Whalley in Bloom, organised an afternoon tea and a Christmas lunch for our older residents, painted benches, attended Longridge Field Day and gleaned surplus fruit.

Collection bins were placed in supermarkets, doctor's surgeries, church halls and opticians for donations of usable spectacles and empty blister packs.

The second annual Whalley Day was held at Whalley Abbey during Heritage weekend in September. The event is supported by the Abbey, local businesses and organisations with the aim of bringing together the local community for a day of games, craft stalls, competitions, entertainment and food. The event raised £1,224 which has been deposited in the Whalley Day charity account.

The Charity Account Income of £10,209 was raised through a concert, donations, book sales, Whalley Day, tabletop sales, an auction and raffles,

The Club Account Income of £4,483 comes from membership fees and a few events identified as non-charitable. The fees are used to pay membership subscriptions to Lions District/MultiDistrict and Lions International.

Annual Report for the year ended 30th June 2022

Throughout the year the CIO held various functions to raise charitable funds which were donated to worthy causes both in the community and wider charitable giving.

These included a concert which raised £520 for Brain Tumour Research and £239 for Marie Curie from a street collection. £462 was donated to Ukraine and members also helped to process clothes, toys and food for the appeal. A donation of £250 was given to Secret Santa, a charity which distributes Christmas gifts to deserving children in the district and £250 was donated to Milly's Smiles. A free coffee morning for residents is held every month at Whalley Methodist church and advice and support is available from Lions members if needed. To help with ongoing costs a donation of £100 was given to the church.

Whalley and District Lions Club has worked in partnership with the Flood Action Group for many years and this year we purchased resilience items at a cost of £815.

In October the Lions facilitated in the raising of funds for Billington Remembers, a group of residents who organise the Remembrance Day Service each year in Billington.

In September the first Whalley Day, a village show formed in partnership with Whalley Abbey took place during Heritage weekend. The event was supported by local businesses and organisations with the aim of bringing together the community for a day of entertainment with food and craft stalls, games and competitions. The event raised £1631 which has been deposited in the general charity account.

Members organised village clean ups, supported Whalley in Bloom, organised a Jubilee lunch and a Christmas lunch for older residents, collected items for the Ribble Valley Food Bank, held an Easter egg hunt for local children, collected usable spectacles for recycling and gleaned pumpkins in Staffordshire which produced enough food to feed 20,000 people.

The Charity Account Income of £3315.31 was raised through table top sales, donations, Whalley Day, grants, product sales and coffee mornings.

The Club Account Income of £7642.75 comes from membership fees, grants and events identified as non-charitable. The fees are used to pay membership subscriptions to Lions District/Multi District and International.

Annual Report for the financial year ended 30th June 2021

Although the past financial year has been a difficult time due to covid lockdowns and restrictions, the Club has still managed to hold various events and activities, including holding outdoor table-top sales which raised income. In the year the Club has made donations to support other charities and not for profit organisations who were also experiencing difficulties due to covid, including East Lancashire Hospice, Derian House Children's Hospice, Brain Tumour Research and Ribble Valley Food Bank. Also in conjunction with local families the Club raised funds for Manchester Children's Hospital and The Royal British Legion.

The Club organised Whalley village clean ups, supported Whalley in Bloom with planting and helped with food distribution to vulnerable local residents during covid lockdowns.

The Club have also worked in partnership with Whalley & Billington Flood Action Group for many years and we continue to support their flood resilience campaign for residents and businesses in and around Whalley. A total of £5241.80 (2020 : £2246.96) was spent from the flood account grant, originally received from the Lions International Foundation in 2020, and the Club gave grants to local residents affected by flooding and also bought items for flood resilience volunteers including multi-way radios and protective clothing.

In January 2021 the Club partnered with Whalley Abbey (Church of England, Diocese of Blackburn) to help organise an annual Whalley village show, the aim being to bring together the communities of Whalley and surrounding villages. The show would take place during Heritage Weekend in September 2021 and hopefully become an annual event.

The Charity Account Income of £1548.54 (2020 : £2529.22) was raised through table-top sales and a tombolo. The Club Account Income of £3327.89 (2020 : £3281.84) is from membership fees and events identified as non-charitable. The fees are used to pay membership subscriptions to Lions District, UK Multi-District and Lions International.
