Spectacles are recycled & trees planted.

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TRUSTEES REPORT 2024-2025 – BURNLEY LIONS CLUB (CIO)

Trustees remained the same this year.

Members distributed 16 Easter eggs to raise funds, and they manned a stall at the Rotarians' Classic Car Show.

Lions obtained 420 whips from the Woodland Trust and assisted 'Trees for Burnley', Council employees and other volunteers to plant them and another 300 trees provided by Burnley Council.

Lions packed a total of 3,720 pairs of used spectacles for recycling through the Lions' program to be reused in developing countries.

Furniture, bedding, white goods, and a wheelchair puller were provided, and a large contribution made towards purchasing a vandalised disability scooter, benefiting several people in need.

222 'Message in a Bottle' containers were distributed, mostly to elderly recipients.

Work started on organising the club's third exhibition 'Sight and Sound' for the visually and hearing impaired for October 2025 with sixteen stalls already booked.

Members continue to run the Burnley Macular Society Support Group for those suffering from macular degeneration, providing monthly opportunities to meet others with the same condition, receive information from service providers and enjoy some entertainment and outings.

TRUSTEES REPORT 2023-2024 – BURNLEY LIONS CLUB (CIO)

Trustees remained the same this year.

16 Easter eggs were distributed to raise funds and the 10K race was organised for the last time. Lions assisted at a tree planting session on 4th February. 2,876 pairs of spectacles were packed for recycling through the Lions' scheme for reuse in third world countries. Some families in need were supported with vouchers or food parcels; 192 'Message in a bottle' containers were handed out to mainly elderly people; and the Burnley Macular Society support group continued supporting those suffering from macular degeneration.

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TRUSTEES REPORT 2022-2023 – BURNLEY LIONS CLUB (CIO)

Membership has remained the same this year.

Funds were raised mainly by placing 16 Easter eggs in various establishments and from organising the Towneley 10K road race.

About 300 trees were planted on 08/01/23 along with Trees for Burnley and Burnley BC; 1200 pairs of spectacles were taken to Bury Lions for onward transport with others to Lions HQ in Birmingham; 147 Message in a Bottle containers were given and distributed; two lions run the Macular Society support group in Burnley. Monthly meetings include a summer outing, Christmas lunch and speakers or entertainment; St John's junior school was entered for the Lions' District Peace Poster Competition but did not win this year.

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TRUSTEES REPORT 2020-2021 – BURNLEY LIONS CLUB (CIO)

We were sad this year to lose three trustees/members, S & C Hunt and D Pascoe.

Covid restrictions severely affected the club's ability to raise funds, with Easter egg receipts well down (shops and public house closures) and inability to run the annual 10K race, which would have been a large gathering of people. However enough was raised to allow the number of grants shown and to prepare for the delayed 10k race later in the year. Only one session of tree planting was possible, 105 being planted in April; 450 pairs of used spectacles were recycled; and the local Macular Society support group monthly meetings or outings were organised and supported by members.
