

# **All Things Small and Green (no 1181768)**

## **Trustees' Annual Report**

**01.04.2021 – 31.03.22**

### **Objectives and Activities**

#### **1. Purposes**

The Charity's purposes are to:

- Promote afforestation for the benefit of the public for the general improvement of land or of the environment
- Promote the conservation and enhancement of the natural environment and the advancement of public education therein with particular reference to deforestation and other effects of the release of carbon dioxide emissions into the atmosphere and the encouragement of afforestation.

#### **2. Activities**

In the period 01.04.21 – 31.03.22, further trees were added to the groves that the Charity had set up previously through Trees for Life (registered Scottish charity SC021303). The trees were donated by the Charity via donations it received and by supporters of the Charity donating direct to Trees for Life.

- 60 trees were added to The Scientists Grove (<https://treesforlife.org.uk/groves/78550/>).
- 292 trees and £90 were added to the Friends of All Things Small and Green Grove (<https://treesforlife.org.uk/groves/84303/>).
- No additional trees were added to the Academics Grove which continues to have 195 trees and £3 in donations (<https://treesforlife.org.uk/groves/88880/>).

In relation to groves that the Charity has helped to set up:

- 144 trees were added to the UCL Grove <https://treesforlife.org.uk/groves/144298/>.
- 902 trees were added to the Cognitive Science Society grove (<https://cognitivesciencesociety.org/cognitive-science-society-grove/>)
- 85 trees and £4 were added to the Imperial College Centre for Structural Biology grove (<https://treesforlife.org.uk/groves/300267/>)

All donations received directly by the Charity were applied to either the Scientists, Friends of or Academics groves. The Trustees have at all times had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

### **Achievements and Performance**

During this third year of the Charity's existence, it has continued to focus on native reforestation as a means to improve the environment for the benefit of the public and

mitigate the impact of carbon emissions, working through Trees for Life, the long established and well respected charity based in Scotland in the UK.

The Charity has continued to encourage donations to its groves and to those groves that it helped other organisations to set up. In this financial year, another 1,483 trees have been planted and separately £94 donated.

### Financial Review

As mentioned above, the Trustees apply all donations received by the Charity to the Scientists, Friends of and Academics groves. Given the way that the charity currently operates, the Trustees do not consider it necessary to hold reserves. The Charity has no overheads.

### Structure, Governance and Management

The Charity is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation operating under a standard CIO constitution. Trustees are appointed for a 4 year term and every trustee must be appointed by a resolution passed at a properly convened meeting of the charity trustees.




