The surveys aimed to determine the level of investment needed to refurbish the existing building, pool, and associated facilities.</p> <p>However, rising costs associated with the Netherhall School pool and restrictions imposed by the school's governors led the trustees to explore the feasibility of constructing a new pool on or near The Wave in Maryport.</p> <p>In 2019, additional funding was obtained through the Bright Ideas Fund (Power to Change) to support a swimming needs assessment and feasibility study. This study incorporated capital and ongoing revenue costs, along with a series of community consultations. The final report, completed in February 2020, was shared with Allerdale Borough Council and local councillors, who expressed their support for reintroducing swimming facilities to Maryport.</p> <p>Trustees continued to collaborate with members of the Maryport Regeneration team to advance the project. In 2021, Allerdale Borough Council confirmed that a new swimming pool was included in a series of regeneration initiatives for the town, with funding secured through the Future High Street Fund (FHS) and the Heritage Action Zone (HAZ).</p> <p>Allerdale Borough Council ceased to exist when the new unitary authority, Cumberland Council took over on 1st April 2023. Due to rising costs and long-term revenue implications, the Council decided not to progress with the swimming pool plans – see here. Therefore, the trustees have decided to close the CIO as there is no other viable alternative in Maryport.</p>







<p>Summary of the main achievements of the charity, identifying the difference the charity's work has made to the circumstances of its beneficiaries and any wider benefits to society as a whole.</p>	<p>Para 1.20</p>	<p>Since the charity was established, trustees secured funding to complete surveys on the old swimming pool building at Netherhall School to find out what investment was required to refurbish the existing building, pool and associated plant.</p> <p>Due to increasing cost associated to the pool at Netherhall School and restrictions put in place by the governors, the trustees decided to investigate the possibility of building a new pool on or next to The Wave in Maryport.</p> <p>In 2019, further funding was secured via the Bright Ideas Fund (Power to Change) to pay for a swimming needs assessment and feasibility study to incorporate capital and ongoing revenue costs, along with running community consultations. The report was finalised in February 2020. This was presented to Allerdale Borough Council and local councillors who were supportive of plans to bring swimming provision back to Maryport.</p> <p>Trustees have continued to engage with representatives from the Maryport Regeneration team to develop the plans further. In 2021, Allerdale Borough Council confirmed that the development of a new swimming pool is part of a number of regeneration projects for the town, with funding secure via the Future High Street Fund (FHS) and Heritage Action Zone (HAZ).</p> <p>Trustees have been engaged with the consultants who are designing the initial plans and designs ahead of the construction phase in 2022/23.</p>



The report was finalised in February 2020. 
