Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	Para 1.17	To promote for the benefit of the inhabitants of Maryport and the surrounding area the provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time activities in the interests of social welfare with the object of improving the condition of life of the said inhabitants, in particular by the provision of swimming facilities.

Para 1.17 and 1.19	Trustees did engage with representatives from the county and district councils, local councillors and officers of Allerdale Borough Council. They have also engaged with the local community as part of a consultation in relation to new swimming facilities. Meetings with funders have also taken place. However, the decision by the local authority in May 2023 to not progress the swimming pool has meant the CIO has been dormant since.

## Achievements and Performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity, identifying the difference the charity's work has made to the circumstances of its beneficiaries and any wider benefits to society as a whole.	Para 1.20	<p>Since its establishment, the charity's trustees secured funding to conduct surveys of the old swimming pool building at Netherhall School. The surveys aimed to determine the level of investment needed to refurbish the existing building, pool, and associated facilities.</p> <p>However, rising costs associated with the Netherhall School pool and restrictions imposed by the school's governors led the trustees to explore the feasibility of constructing a new pool on or near The Wave in Maryport.</p> <p>In 2019, additional funding was obtained through the Bright Ideas Fund (Power to Change) to support a swimming needs assessment and feasibility study. This study incorporated capital and ongoing revenue costs, along with a series of community consultations. The final report, completed in February 2020, was shared with Allerdale Borough Council and local councillors, who expressed their support for reintroducing swimming facilities to Maryport.</p> <p>Trustees continued to collaborate with members of the Maryport Regeneration team to advance the project. In 2021, Allerdale Borough Council confirmed that a new swimming pool was included in a series of regeneration initiatives for the town, with funding secured through the Future High Street Fund (FHS) and the Heritage Action Zone (HAZ).</p> <p>Allerdale Borough Council ceased to exist when the new unitary authority, Cumberland Council took over on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023. Due to rising costs and long-term revenue implications, the Council decided not to progress with the swimming pool plans – see <a href="#">here</a>. Therefore, the trustees have decided to close the CIO as there is no other viable alternative in Maryport.</p>

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period	Para 1.21	The Charity held cash of £12,017.85 at the year end. As the project has not progressed, £12,000 of these funds will be returned to the funder. The remaining will be donated to a similar charity.




