Para 1.20	<p>During 2022/23 Shedditi Men's Shed started to rebuild activities after pausing for Covid. A new location for the shed was found, the main activity for the year was clearing, cleaning and equipping this workshop. The workshop was opened in March 23 and a core of 10 volunteers has been established.</p> <p>To assist with attracting volunteers and benefit to the community the shed extended its activities to include wider sustainability activities, such as tree planting and rewilding.</p> <p>Two events were held to promote volunteering and sustainability in and around Swavesey.</p> <p>The benefits of these events and the shed activities are wide and varied, including better wellbeing, increased knowledge of sustainability issues and the value of biodiversity.</p>
