### TRUSTEES ANNUAL REPORT

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025.

### OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

To relieve the needs of people in North West England, including but not exclusively in the Blackburn and wider East Lancashire regions who are in need, hardship or distress, and in particular by providing support, education, and temporary and longer terms accommodation with the object of improving their conditions of life within a Christian ethos.

The trustees have complied with the requirements of the Charity Commission with regard to public benefit.

### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Arise Restoration Centre continued to provide its Crisis Intervention and Crisis Prevention services through the application of its three component “Health and Wellbeing Initiative”.

- (I) “Feed Our People”
- (II) “Grow Your Own”, and
- (III) “Cycle for Life” targeting vulnerable adults in Blackburn with Darwen Borough who are afflicted with poverty, hunger, addictions, mental health distress at various levels, and loneliness.

In September 2025 Arise extended its operations to a second location at Unit 4 --- 14 Cornhill, Arndale Shopping Centre, Accrington BB5 1EX, Hyndburn Borough, serving the same target population as in Blackburn with Darwen.

In November 2025 Arise became a community member of “Neighbourly Food Programme” and was assigned to two Aldi stores, collecting surplus food Wednesdays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

Arise has been a community member of FareShare Food Go Scheme since April 2021, collecting surplus food weekly from two ASDA and two TESCO stores. FareShare’s Arise report for the period April 2021 thru December 2025 is as follows:

Total Collections Made	546
Total Food Weight Collected	16,816Kgs
Total Meals Equivalent	40,038 Meals

Arise is currently distributing food, hygiene products, and clothes to over 900 people weekly in Blackburn with Darwen Borough.

Arise's team has grown to 11 dedicated volunteers

The trustees have complied with the requirements of the Charity Commission with regard to public benefit.

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE**

Arise Restoration Centre continues to provide crisis intervention services and crisis prevention services for people who are in high risk exposure to, for example, hunger, poverty, homelessness, domestic violence, or negative and destructive health lifestyles which can or may lead to depravity or suicide.

The charity has responded to post COVID-19 challenges through its '**Hunger and Mental Health Initiative 2022**' due to the fact that hunger is one of the most overlooked factors of mental health in the UK. Its methodology is the application of three separate but complimentary programmes:

"Feed Our People Crusade" (food distribution),

"Grow Your Own – Grow Your Wellbeing" (community gardening).

"Cycle for Life" – providing physical and mental health activities in Witton Park, Blackburn with its 12 donated bicycles.

We are now distributing food to over 400 adults and 300 children weekly in Blackburn and Darwen, all on very limited funding.

#### **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

In June 2023 Project Arise launched a new programme called "Cycle For Life" after receiving a grant from Community Asset Fund to purchase 12 bikes. This programme gives disadvantaged people, especially those in Recovery from drug and alcohol addiction and mental health distress at various levels, access to riding bikes on the trails in Wittion Park, Blackburn in collaboration with Blackburn with Darwen Health and Wellbeing programme at Witton Park.
