AS FAR AS INFORMATION HAS BEEN FORTHCOMING THE SUCCESS RATE OF THESE CLIENTS GOING ON TO FIND WORK HAS BEEN AROUND THE 20 PERCENT MARK. COLLABORATING WITH COUNCILS AND HOUSING TRUSTS ACCOMMODATION WAS FOUND FOR 2 INDIVIDUALS IN DEVON. TWO INDIVIDUALS WERE REFERRED TO MENTAL HEALTH CASE WORKERS FOR PROFESSIONAL TREATMENT FOR THEIR CONDITIONS.





