Trustees' Report for the Period 1st April 2024 to 31st March 2025

We are delighted to present the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church UK report for the financial year spanning 1st April 2024 to 31st March 2025 on behalf of the Charity's Trustees.

The Syro-Malankara Catholic Church U.K.

The Syro-Malankara Catholic Church UK belongs to the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church, one of the individual Churches in the Universal Catholic Church, headed by His Holiness Pope Francis. The Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK is under the direct jurisdiction of His Eminence Cardinal Baselios Cleemis Catholicos and His Excellency Bishop Yoohanon Mar Theodosius, serving as the Apostolic Visitor. The Syro-Malankara Catholic Church UK is a C.I.O. (Charitable Incorporated Organisation) in England and Wales, registered under registration number 1182359.

Objectives and Activities

Based on the constitution of a C.I.O., the money received by the trustees is to be used to fulfil the following objectives:

“The advancement of the Catholic Faith and Christian beliefs for the benefit of the public by the statements of beliefs of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church”.

This objective is achieved by organising the celebration of sacraments and religious services, prayer meetings, and providing accommodation and other support for clergy (including those in retirement).

This charity also supports other individuals engaged in the advancement of the following objectives:

- The advancement of education in accordance with the teaching of the Catholic Church. This is to be achieved through training individuals and groups, producing and distributing literature and broadcasting information using modern media to enlighten others about the Catholic Faith.
- The relief of poverty and suffering and other such charitable purposes for the benefit of the public are consistent with the doctrines of the Catholic Church.
- The acquisition, provision and maintenance of land and buildings are to be used primarily for the above activities and are to be available for hire by other communities.
- Any other related activities supporting the promotion of Christian beliefs in the UK. Or overseas, including donations to individuals or organisations promoting the Christian Faith.
- Any other activities which, in the opinion of the lawfully appointed Bishop of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church UK, are necessary to achieve the objectives of the Charity.

Annual Report for the Catechism Activities

The Department of Central Catechism has successfully concluded another enriching year of religious education and spiritual development. The Catechism academic year runs from September to July. Throughout the year, various engaging activities were organised to foster a deeper understanding of the faith among our children. We focused on teaching the essential aspects of Catholic doctrine, morality, and sacraments to ensure a comprehensive learning experience. Regular Catechism classes were conducted through interactive sessions, group discussions, and multimedia presentations, creating a dynamic and immersive learning environment, and incorporating community-building initiatives such as prayer services, retreats, outreach activities, regional camps, and Bible quiz competitions. Catechism Day and Teachers' Day were celebrated in all mission centres. The Catechism students actively participated in the cultural programs and Holy Mass during the Feasts of the patron saint of their mission.

First, Holy Communion and Confirmation ceremonies were celebrated with great joy and reverence, marking significant milestones in the spiritual journeys of our catechism students. The dedication of our experienced Catechists and the active participation of students and their families contributed to the program's success. Reflecting on the year's achievements, we look forward to continuing our mission of nurturing strong, informed, compassionate individuals grounded in their Catholic faith.

Malankara Catholic Youth Movement

The Malankara Catholic Youth Movement is the organisation that organises various youth activities. Notable events include a memorable two-day residential Youth Camp, leading the Holy Rosary, conducting Sports Days, and successfully hosting online events such as the Veni Veni Emmanuel Carol and Nativity Play competition, and the Lenten Retreat. The MCYM, in commemoration of Servant of God Mar Ivanios, conducts Ivanian Prayer Meetings every two months. MCYM Central Secretariat emphasises weekly meetings and the formation of an MCYM Senate to elect office bearers, fostering passion and unity among youths for the greater glory of Lord Jesus Christ in the United Kingdom. In closing, we seek intercession from Mother Mary, St. Francis of Assisi, and all saints for the continued growth of MCYM as a strong and vibrant movement.

Mothers Forum

Mothers Forum (Mathru Samajam) has the following goals: Prayer and Charitable deeds. All married women in the parish are eligible to join the Mothers Forum. Mothers Forum is one of the most active and pious apostolates of the Church and contributes its talents effectively to the spiritual growth of the parish. Mothers Forum has been established in every mission centre with an elected president, secretary and treasurer as its office bearers. This apostolate leads a weekly

prayer service via an online platform, including recitation of the Holy Rosary and evening prayer. A one-day Lenten retreat was conducted. Many members attended the retreat, and Sr. Ann Maria, a renowned Evangelist in the UK, gave a spiritual talk. Mothers Forum has always been at the forefront of supporting programmes conducted in the church for the youth and catechism students. Along with their prayers, they wholeheartedly support the organisers in all possible ways. Active participation in the church choir, teaching Catechism, and preparing food for mission members on various occasions are just a few roles they undertake.

Gospel Ministry Team (Suvisesha Sangam)

“Go into the entire world and proclaim the Good News to the whole creation” (Mk.16:15).

The Syro-Malankara Catholic Suvisesha Sangam is a holy renewal movement grounded in the spirituality of the Malankara Catholic Church, proclaiming, celebrating, and living the Good News. The members of the Suvisesha Sangam should follow 25 spiritual ways of life based on the spirituality of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church, precisely: Liturgy of the hour, Sacraments, especially Holy Qurbano and confession, Lent, abstinence, fasting, Bible reading, meditation, prayer, spirituality based on self-sanctification and a life of witnessing.

The gospel ministry programme meets regularly and includes various spiritual awakening classes and meditations, Bible courses, Liturgical studies, dogmatic studies, moral studies, preaching ministry, Church history, and other relevant subjects.

Malankara Catholic Council of the U.K. Meetings

The Syro-Malankara Catholic Council UK Members met seven times in this financial year, four in person and three online, to discuss and plan various activities related to the missions in the United Kingdom. The National Council is led by Rev Dr Kuriakose Thadathil, its president.

At each national council and executive committee meeting, presidential addresses were delivered, and the national council was updated on the status of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church in the UK. At this point, the national council members were allowed to share their views on the Church's development. The matters raised were discussed extensively during the meetings, and potential action steps were developed. Under the direct leadership of the National Council members, the following activities were organised: the Walsingham Pilgrimage and the Commemoration of Servant of God Mar Ivanios.

Structure, governance, and management

Syro-Malankara Catholic Church UK is a C.I.O. constituted by the declaration of a foundation C.I.O. dated 6th March 2019. The Syro-Malankara Catholic Church UK covers England and Wales with 18 mission centres, and 2 in Scotland (Glasgow and Aberdeen) have been formed. As the charity's trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ("the Act").



1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Charities Act 2011 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its estimated useful life.

Furniture and fittings	- 20% on reducing balance basis
Motor vehicles	- 20% on reducing balance basis

The Trustees have carried out a full impairment review in accordance with FRS11, as a result of which no depreciation charge is made in respect of freehold property on the grounds that the estimated residual value is not materially different from its carrying value in the Balance Sheet.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Trustees' Report

For the Period Ended 31st March 2022

We are delighted to present the report of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K. for the financial year 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022 on behalf of the Trustees of the Charity.

The Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K.

The Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K. belongs to the Syro Malankara Catholic Church, one of the individual Churches in the Universal Catholic Church, headed by His Holiness Pope Francis. The Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K. is under the direct jurisdiction of His Eminence Cardinal Baselios Cleemis Catholicos and His Excellency Bishop Yoochanon Mar Theodosius, serving as the Apostolic Visitor. The Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K. is a C.I.O. (Charitable Incorporated Organization) in England and Wales with the registration number – 1182359.

Objectives and Activities

Based on the constitution of a C.I.O., all the money received by the trustees is to be used to fulfil this objective: the advancement of the Catholic Faith and Christian beliefs for the benefit of the public in accordance with the statements of beliefs of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church.

This objective is achieved by; the organisation of the celebration of sacraments and religious services, prayer meetings, missions and similar events, the provision of accommodation and other support for clergy (including in retirement) and other individuals engaged in the advancement of the following Objectives:

- The advancement of education in accordance with the teaching of the Catholic Church and the training of individuals and groups, and the production and distribution of literature and the broadcasting of information using modern media to enlighten others about the Catholic Faith.
- The relief of poverty and suffering and other such charitable purposes for the benefit of the public as are consistent with the doctrines of the Catholic Church;
- The acquisition, provision and maintenance of land and buildings to be used primarily for the above purposes and also to be available for hire or use by other community groups.
- Any other related activities which support the promotion of Christian beliefs in the U.K. or overseas, including donations to individuals or organisations engaged in the promotion of the Christian Faith.
- Any other activities which, in the opinion of the lawfully appointed Bishop of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K., are necessary for the achievement of the objects of the Charity.

The year 2021-2022 was another valuable step towards the growth of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church in the region of the United Kingdom. Our Lord God Almighty showered His grace on us abundantly, which was visible through the formation of four more Missions in the region of the United Kingdom. Moreover, this year, the region was blessed with the visits of our beloved bishops which as always, infused positive energy among the faithful.

Achievements and Performance

To achieve the aim of the Charity, the trustees conducted various activities through the different Apostolates of the Church, such as - Catechism, Youth Apostolate, Family Apostolate and the Gospel Ministry Team (Suvisesha Sangam).

Activities for Children

The Charity arranged special activities throughout the year to support the spiritual and moral growth of the children. Sunday Schools are established in every Mission under the guidance of a Central Governing body. The academic year was divided into two terms with two-term examinations under the supervision of the central board. Examples of activities revolving around children are:

a. Sequla Christi

The Charity arranged 'Sequla Christi' - Children's Camp online on 17th July 2021. The primary aim of the camp was to provide an opportunity for the children to have a better understanding of each other and thus build good relationships. Further, the camp provided a platform to enhance the children's spiritual understanding via comprehensive and well-structured online presentations based on the Christian faith.

b. Catechism Teachers Training

The Catechetical Teacher's Training was arranged for the teachers; teachers from all Missions participated in the training sessions in order to get a proper understanding of Church teachings and improve their teaching skills. The training was conducted by Reverend Father Antony Kakkanatte.

c. Best Sunday School Award

The best Sunday School Award was awarded this year to encourage catechism for children and teachers.

Activities for Youth

Malankara Catholic Youth Movement (M.C.Y.M.)

To strengthen the youngsters, the Charity promoted the formation of the Malankara Catholic Youth Movement (M.C.Y.M.) in the Mission centres. M.C.Y.M. is an association of youngsters across the global Syro Malankara Catholic Church, focusing on the development of the youths and their positive influence on the Church and Society. M.C.Y.M. is working at the Unit, Regional and National levels under the leadership of the mission committee and central committee. The vital aim of M.C.Y.M. is the development of youth and their positive contribution to the development of Society in general.

M.C.Y.M. conducted the following activities this year:

- a. An Action plan Inauguration was held on 10th July 2021.
- b. An Ivanian Revival Quiz Competition was performed on 31st July 2021.
- c. The Ivanian Prayer Youth Meeting was done on the First and Third Saturdays of every month.
- d. A Leadership Meeting was held on 2nd October 2021.
- e. A University Information Session was provided on 23rd October 2021.
- f. Feliz Navidad 2021-a Christmas Programme was celebrated on 27th December 2021.

Mothers Forum

Mothers Forum (Mathru Samajam) has the following goals: Prayer and Charitable deeds. All married women in the parish are eligible for Mothers Forum membership. Mothers Forum is one of the most active pious organisations of the Church and contributes its talents for the spiritual growth of the parish very effectively. Realising its importance, Mother's Forum has been formed in every Mission Center with an elected President, Secretary and Treasurer as its office bearers. Monthly family prayer meetings have been conducted since the beginning and charity works are the areas in which the group focuses. This has been exercised by the effective use of social media to keep in contact with each other regularly. During Lent, online prayer meetings were organised and led by this forum.

Gospel Ministry Team

"Go into the entire world and proclaim the Good News to the whole creation" (Mk.16:15). This is the missionary mandate of Jesus to the Apostles and the Church. Preaching the Gospel, therefore, is the prime duty of the Church and so Evangelisation is one of the objectives of the Charity. It is the greatest need of the time to prepare the faithful to give witness to Jesus Christ by preaching the Gospel with a burning zeal in the Spirit. By baptism, every Christian is called to holiness and preaching of the Gospel.

The gospel ministry programme meets regularly, which includes various spiritual awakening classes and meditations, Bible courses, Liturgical studies, dogmatic studies, moral studies, Preaching Ministry, Church History and relevant subjects.

Malankara Catholic Council of U.K. Meetings

This year Malankara Council Members met online several times to discuss and plan various activities related to the Mission Centers in the United Kingdom. On 30.01.22, a face-to-face meeting was held to elect new office-bearers for a two year term.

Structure, governance and management

Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K. is a C.I.O. constituted by Declaration of a Foundation C.I.O. dated 6th March 2019.

The Syro Malankara Catholic Church U.K. covers the whole of England and Wales with 17 Mission centres; two in Scotland (Glasgow and Aberdeen) have been formed to date. Various activities of the Charity are implemented through these Mission centres. The following are the Mission centres:

1. Aberdeen, 2. Ashford, 3. Belfast, 4. Bristol, 5. Cardiff, 6. Coventry, 7. Croydon, 8. East London, 9. Glasgow, 10. Gloucester, 11. Ipswich, 12. Liverpool, 13. Luton, 14. Manchester, 15. Northampton, 16. Nottingham, 17. Sheffield, 18. Southampton, 19. West London. At present, the celebration of Holy Mass and other Sacraments are arranged on a regular basis with the support of the local Roman Catholic diocese.

Trustees are supported by the Malankara Catholic Council of U.K. Members, who were elected from each mission centre. They offer their services voluntarily for the growth of the Charity. The Council meetings are held on a regular basis to plan and implement various activities and to monitor the whole operation.



We are delighted to present the report of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK, for the financial year 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021, on behalf of the Trustees of the Charity.

The Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK

The Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK belongs to the Syro Malankara Catholic Church, one of the individual Churches in the Universal Catholic Church, headed by His Holiness Pope Francis. The Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK is under the direct jurisdiction of His Eminence Cardinal Basellos Cleemis and His Excellency Bishop Yoochanon Mar Theodosius serving as the Apostolic Visitor. The Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK is a Charitable Incorporated Organization in England and Wales with the registration number – 1182359.

Objectives and Activities

Based on the constitution of CIO, all the money received by the trustees is to be used for the fulfilment of the objectives: the advancement of the Catholic Faith and Christian beliefs for the benefit of the public in accordance with the statements of beliefs of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church in particular by:

The organisation of the celebration of sacraments and religious services, prayer meetings, missions and similar events;

The provision of accommodation and other support for clergy (including in retirement) and other individuals engaged in the advancement of the Objectives;

- The advancement of education in accordance with the teaching of the Catholic Church and the training of individuals and groups and the production and distribution of literature and the broadcasting of information using modern media to enlighten others about the Catholic Faith;
- The relief of poverty and suffering and other such charitable purposes for the benefit of the public as are consistent with the doctrines of the Catholic Church;
- The acquisition, provision and maintenance of land and buildings to be used primarily for the above purposes, and also to be available for hire or use by other community groups;
- Any other related activities which support the promotion of Christian beliefs in the UK or overseas, including donations to individuals or organisations engaged in the promotion of the Christian Faith;
- Any other activities which in the opinion of the lawfully appointed Bishop of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK are necessary for the achievement of the objects of the Charity.

As the charity is in its beginning stage, the above objectives can be achieved by the planning and implementation of various activities in the future months. With the help of Rev. Priests, Malankara Council Members and volunteers, the trustees plan various activities and implement them. The charity is very grateful to all those who supported during the past year and acknowledge that without their help, it wouldn't have been possible to carry out the various activities conducted concerning the objectives of the charity.

The year 2020-2021 was another valuable step towards the growth of the Syro Malankara Catholic Church in the region of United Kingdom. Our Lord God Almighty showered His grace on us abundantly, some of which was visible through the formation of two more Missions in the region of the United Kingdom. Moreover, this year, the region was blessed with the visits of our beloved bishops which as always, infused positive energy among the faithful.

Achievements and Performance

To achieve the aim of the charity, the trustees conducted various activities through the different Apostolate of the Church such as - Catechism, Youth Apostolate, Family Apostolate and Gospel Ministry Team (Suvisesha Sangam).

Activities for Children

The Charity had arranged special activities throughout the year to support the spiritual and moral growth of the children. Sunday Schools are established in every Mission under the guidance of a Central Governing body. The academic year was divided into two terms with two-term examinations under supervision of central board.

a. Biblia - Children's Camp @ home

The Charity arranged 'Biblia - Children's Camp @ home Conference on 6th and 7th June 2020. To strengthen and motivate our children during this time we have planned two days online camp. The primary aim of the camp was to provide an opportunity for the children to have a better understanding of each other and thus build good relationships. Further, the camp provided a platform to enhance the children's spiritual understanding via comprehensive and well-structured online presentations based on Christian faith.

b. Catechism Teachers Training

With the theme of 'Transform, Lead, Inspire', the Catechetical Teacher's Training was arranged for the teachers. Teachers from the all Missions participated in the training sessions in order to get a proper understanding of Church teachings and improve their teaching skills.

b. Best Sunday school Award

Best Sunday School Award was instituted this year to encourage catechism children and teachers.

Activities for Youth

Malankara Catholic Youth Movement (MCYM)

To strengthen the youngsters, the Charity promoted the formation of Malankara Catholic Youth Movement (MCYM) in the Mission centres. MCYM is an association of youngsters across the global Syro Malankara Catholic Church, with its focus on the development of the youths and their positive influence on Church and society. MCYM is working at the Unit, Regional and National level under the leadership of mission committee and central committee. The important aim of MCYM is the development of youth and their positive contribution for the development of the Society in general.

a. Alpha 2020 Action plan Inauguration

The event was held online on the 20th of June 2020.

b. Kerygma Youth Retreat

A two-day youth retreat Kerygma has held on 27th and 28th June 2020. The virtually held retreat was for the youth in the UK, led by Rev Fr Daniel Poovannathil. It was primarily an opportunity to the youth to comprehend and explore solutions to the difficulties of leading a spiritual faith filled life in a notion gearing a secular life style.

c. Ivanian 2020

MCYM region of UK organised Ivanian a virtual event in commemoration of servant of God Archbishop Mar Ivanios on the 1st of August 2020. It was a national event held as a virtual competition between the subregions alongside individual participation from creative arts.

d. Gloria

The MCYM youth in the region of UK organized Gloria as a part of Christmas celebration. They gathered through a virtual zoom platform to celebrate Christmas. It was session filled with fun activities including ice breakers, Christmas carols and a mini quiz competition

e. Lenten retreat

A Lenten retreat was conducted on 27th March 2021. The retreat was conducted by Rev Fr Justin John Chempanal via zoom. As a young priest his perspective and talks were incredible relatable to the contemporary issues faced by our youth and provide convincing and philosophical answers to the challenging questions from the youth.

Mothers Forum

Mothers Forum (Mathru Samajam) functions with the following objectives: Pray and Charitable deeds. All married women in the parish are eligible for Mothers Forum membership. Mothers Forum is one of the most active pious organizations of the Church and contributes their talents for the spiritual growth of the parish very effectively. Realizing its importance, Mother's Forum has been formed in every Mission Center with an elected President, Secretary and Treasurer as its office bearers. Monthly family prayer meetings have been conducted since beginning and charity works are the areas which the group focuses. This has been exercised by the effective use of social media to keep in contact with each other regularly.

UK Regional Assembly

Gospel Ministry Team

"Go into the entire world and proclaim the Good News to the whole creation" (Mk.16:15). This is the missionary mandate of Jesus to the Apostles and the Church. Preaching the Gospel, therefore, is the prime duty of the Church. Evangelization is one of the objectives of the charity. It is the greatest need of the time to prepare the faithful to give witness to Jesus Christ by preaching the Gospel with a burning zeal in the Spirit. By virtue of baptism, every Christian is called to holiness and preaching of Gospel.

The gospel ministry programme meets regularly which included various spiritual awakening classes and meditations, Bible course, Liturgical studies, dogmatic studies, moral studies, Preaching Ministry, Church History and relevant subjects.

Malankara Catholic Council of UK Meetings

This year Malankara Council Members met online several times to discuss and plan various activities related with the Mission Centers in the United Kingdom.

Structure, governance and management

Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK is Charitable Incorporated Organization (CIO) constituted by Declaration of a Foundation CIO dated on 6th March 2019.

The Syro Malankara Catholic Church UK covers the whole of England with fifteen Mission centres; two in Scotland (Glasgow and Aberdeen) have been formed till to date. Various activities of the charity are implemented through these Mission centres. Following are the Mission centres:

1. Ashford, 2. Aberdeen, 3. Bristol, 4. Coventry, 5. Croydon, 6. East London, 7. Glasgow, 8. Gloucester, 9. Ipswich, 10. Liverpool, 11. Luton, 12. Manchester, 13. Northampton, 14. Nottingham 15. Sheffield 16. Southampton 17. West London. At present, the celebration of Holy Mass and other Sacraments are arranged on a regular basis with the support of local Roman Catholic diocese.



1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention
