Plus donations from our supporters helped us through the year.

The money raised goes to support the families in need who have a child/young person diagnosed with cancer. Families apply through their hospital representative. This year we have issued 118 grants to families in need.

Teenage Cancer Trust Representative, Young Lives Vs Cancer Representatives and Children's Social Workers can make referrals.

Families can be nominated by the hospital representative to Jordan's Weeones, either by post or email. No financial information of family circumstances is requested on the application as we accept that any nominated family is already deemed in need of assistance by the hospital representative.

Grants are issues by cheque and sent by post unless a parent specifically requests a bank transfer usually due to being at the hospital with their child.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The main achievement of our charity this year is that we have been able to support 118 families. Total grants issued to families this year is £17,700, this is £2,550 more than we issued in the previous financial year. This was a great achievement given the current financial situation and charitable giving being less than usual.

We have had some really good feedback and testimonials which we post with permission on our web page.

We continue to cover Birmingham hospitals, Nottingham University Hospital, Leicester Royal Infirmary and Addenbrooks, we cover the East and West Midlands, and parts of East Anglia. Although the families can reside anywhere in the country, a lot travel a long way to reach these specialist hospitals which strains family finances so we are happy to be able to assist the families that need support.

We have also increased our social media followers again and Laura Crofts continues to work hard to engage our followers on all platforms.

Wayne Berridge has completed his level 4 in counselling and is currently working to complete 100hrs clinical practice.

Fundraising achievements

We were very grateful to receive support from the Masonic Associations, Lodge of Welcome, Royal Sussex and Victoria donated a total of £1250 to be made available in the form of grants to families being treated at specialist hospitals.

We also benefited from the Tarro Lounge charity drive where they fundraised for the whole month of June in aid of Jordan's Weeones.

This year we have started to use Charity Collection Tins at our venues and have several establishments holding Tins on their counter.

Both Patron's have continued in tireless support of the charity and we are continuing to grow and looking forward to the coming year and we already have many more events planned.

The Brigstock bring and buy stall run by Patron Jane Steward has continued to be a huge help to us. Along with the plant sales from her produce.

Our Psychic Night raffles run by Patron Yvonne Fielding continues to be a great fundraiser and funds from raffles are much appreciated.

Craft Fairs are attended when invited or where possible.

Bingham Spiritualist Church have supported us with a monthly donation for the year which has been a big boost. We also have a regular donor and hope to encourage more regular givers in the coming year.

Tarro Lounge ran events through June in aid of Jordan's Weeones raising a total of just over £1500.

The money raised goes to support the families in need who have a child/young person diagnosed with cancer. Families apply through their hospital representative. This year we have issued 99 grants to families in need.

Our policy on grant making is referral from hospitals, i.e. the Royal Orthopaedic Hospital in Birmingham, Birmingham Children's Hospital, Nottingham University Hospital, Leicester Royal Infirmary. Teenage Cancer Trust Representative, Young Lives Vs Cancer Representatives and Children's Social Workers can make referrals.

Families can be nominated by the hospital representative to Jordan's Weeones, either by post or email. No financial information of family circumstances is requested on the application as we accept that any nominated family is already deemed in need of assistance by the hospital representative.

Grants are issues by cheque and sent by post.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The main achievement of our charity this year is that we have been able to support 99 families. Total grants issued to families this year is £14050.00. We have had some really good feedback and testimonials which we post with permission on our web page.

We extended our reach again and now cover Birmingham hospitals, Nottingham University Hospital, Leicester Royal Infirmary and Addenbrooks, we now cover the East and West Midlands, and parts of East Anglia. Although the families can reside anywhere in the country, a lot travel a long way to reach these specialist hospitals which strains family finances so we are happy to be able to assist the families that need support.

We have also increased our social media followers. Wayne Berridge's course continues in September for his level 4 in counselling.

We raise money for families by organising events (psychic nights) tickets at £10 through online platform ticket source. Raffle prizes at the event. Craft Fairs and Market Stalls.

This year due to Covid restrictions we were not able to run events. We ran bring and buy sales with an honesty box for payment instead of attending craft fairs this year.

Also plant sales from our Patron.

And donations from our supporters helped us through the year.

The money goes to support the families in need that apply through their hospital representative.

Our policy on grant making is referral from hospitals, i.e. the Royal Orthopaedic Hospital in Birmingham, Birmingham Childrens Hospital, Nottingham University Hospital, Leicester Royal Infirmary. Also Teenage Cancer Trust Representative or ClicSargent Representatives can make referrals.

Families can be nominated by the hospital representative to Jordan's Weeones, either by post or email. No financial information of family circumstances is requested on the application as we accept that any nominated family is already deemed in need of assistance by the hospital representative.

Grants are issues by cheque and sent by post.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The main achievement of our charity this year is that we have been able to support 28 families. Total grants issued to families this year is £4200.00

We extended our reach from just the Birmingham hospitals to the Nottingham University Hospital so we now cover the East and West Midlands. We have reached out to Leicester Royal Infirmary as they are our local hospital, and are now taking applications from them also.

Although our families can reside anywhere in the country, a lot travel a long way to reach these specialist hospitals which strains family finances so we are happy to be able to assist the families that need support.

We have been nominated to the Leicestershire and Rutland Masonic Charity Association for a grant which we are hopeful we will get.

We have also increased our social media followers to over 500 this year so we are getting our name out there. Wayne Berridge published his book on Bereavement and continues to work toward his level 4 in counselling.

Although the year has been difficult in terms of Covid Restrictions we have managed to continue fund raising in non contact ways such as bring and buy sales with honesty boxes and online activity.

We have had some really good feed back and testimonials which we post with permission on our web page.

We are continuing to grow as a charity and looking forward to the coming year.
