1 Statutory information

BIRMINGHAM COUNCIL OF MOSQUES (BCM) is a private company, limited by guarantee, registered in England and Wales, registration number 11052144. The registered office is 188 EDWARD ROAD, BALSALL HEATH, BIRMINGHAM, B12 9LX, UNITED KINGDOM.

2 Compliance with accounting standards

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of FRS 102 Section 1A Small Entities. There were no material departures from that standard.

3 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation
