DURING THE PERIOD THE CHARITY SECURED DONATIONS OF £72,990 FOR THE VARIOUS PROJECTS AND EXPENDED £70,325 OF WHICH GRANTS FOR PROJECTS TOTALLED £69,782. THIS GENERATED A SURPLUS FOR THE PERIOD OF £2,665 WHICH THE TRUSTEES INTEND TO USE FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE. THE TOTAL FUNDS HELD AT THE END OF THE PERIOD WERE £6,916. THE TRUSTEES HAVE A POLICY NOT TO HOLD RESERVES FOR OPERATIONAL COSTS BUT ANY FUNDS HELD WILL BE USED FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE PROJECTS AND ADMINISTRATION COSTS.
